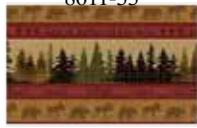

Materials

(Yardages for (4) pillows)

1 Panel	Pillow Panel - Blue (A)	8607P-77
7/8 yard	Large Plaid - Red (B)	8615Y-88
1/3 yard	Trees & Stars - Red (C)	8612-88
1/3 yard	Monotone Window Pane Plaid - Red (D)	8611-88
1/3 yard	Awning Stripe - Blue (E)	8617Y-77
1/3 yard	People Silhouettes - Blue (F)	8608-11
1/3 yard	Monotone Window Pane Plaid - Indigo (G)	8611-77
1/4 yard	Trees & Stars - Brown (H)	8612-38
1/4 yard	Wedding Ring - Brown (I)	8610-38
1/4 yard	Confetti Wedding Ring - Cream (J)	8569-44
2 yards	Large Plaid - Red (K)	8615Y-88
1/2 yard	Wedding Ring - Indigo (L)	8610-77

You will also need:

- 20" x 20" Pillow Form for Pillow 1, 2 and 3.
- 28" x 23" Pillow form for Pillow 4 or see optional instructions to make pillow form

OPTIONAL Pillow Form Instructions:

You will need:

- (2) 28 1/2" x 23 1/2" pieces of muslin fabric
- Fiber fil

1. Place the two 28" x 23" pieces of muslin, right sides together, sew around the two pieces leaving a 4" opening of turning to make the pillow form case.
2. Turn the pillow form case right side out and stuff with the fiber fil.
3. Hand or top stitch the opening, closed.

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Pillow Panel - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 10 1/2" squares, each centered on (1) panel. One for Pillows #1 and #2 and (2) for Pillow #3.
- Fussy cut (1) 20 1/2" x 15 1/2" strip, centered on (2) panels for Pillow #4.

From the Large Plaid - Red (B), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 10 1/2" square for Pillow #1 and (4) 3" squares for Pillow #3.
- (2) 3 1/2" x 28 1/2" WOF strips for Pillow #4.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 3 1/2" x 17 1/2" strips for Pillow #4.

From the Trees & Stars - Red (C), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 10 1/2" square for Pillow #1 and (8) 3" squares for Pillow #3.

From the Monotone Window Pane Plaid - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 10 1/2" square for Pillow #1 and (8) 3" squares for Pillow #3.

From the Awning Stripe - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x square for Pillow #2.

From the People Silhouettes - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x square for Pillow #2.

From the Monotone Window Pane Plaid - Indigo (G), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x square for Pillow #2.

From the Trees & Stars - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3" squares for Pillow #3.

From the Wedding Ring - Brown (I), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares for Pillow #3.

From the Confetti Wedding Ring - Cream (J), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x 22 1/2" WOF strips for Pillow #4.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips for Pillow #4.

From the Large Plaid - Red (K)

(Backs for Pillows #1, #3 and #4), cut:

- (1) 14" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 14" x 20 1/2" strips for Pillow #1.
- (1) 14" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 14" x 20 1/2" strips for Pillow #3.
- (1) 23 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 18" x 23 1/2" strips for Pillow #4.

From the Wedding Ring - Indigo (L)

(Back for Pillow #2), cut:

- (1) 14" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 14" x 20 1/2" strips for Pillow #2.

Sewing Instructions

Pillow #1

1. Sew (1) 10 ½” Fabric A square, (1) 10 ½” Fabric B square, (1) 10 ½” Fabric C square and (1) 10 ½” Fabric D square together to make Pillow Top #1 (Fig. 1).

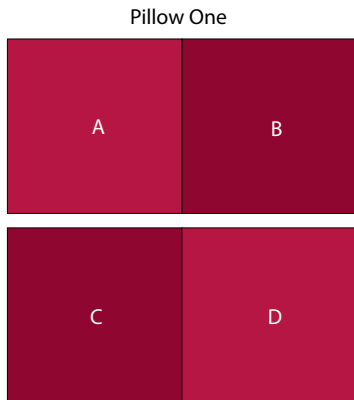

2. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 20 ½” edge approximately ¼”, press and repeat to make a finished edge on one edge of the 14” x 20 ½” Fabric K strip. Repeat with the second 14” x 20 ½” Fabric K strip.

3. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front. Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow (Fig. 2).

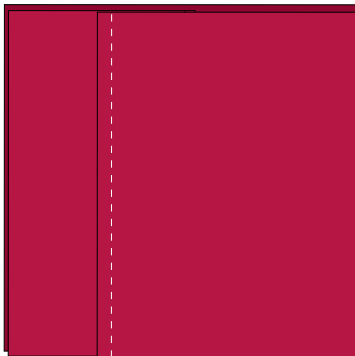

4. Turn the pillow right side out.

5. Insert the pillow form.

Sewing Instructions

Pillow #2

6. Sew (1) 10 ½” Fabric A square, (1) 10 ½” Fabric E square, (1) 10 ½” Fabric F square and (1) 10 ½” Fabric G square together to make Pillow Top #2 (Fig. 3).

7. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 20 ½” edge approximately ¼”, press and repeat to make a finished edge on one edge of the 14” x 20 ½” Fabric L strip. Repeat with the second 14” x 20 ½” Fabric L strip.

8. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front. Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow (Fig. 2).

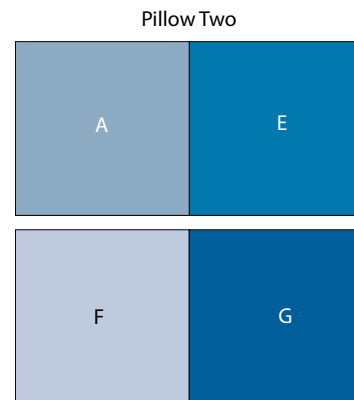

9. Turn the pillow right side out.

10. Insert the pillow form.

Sewing Instructions

Pillow #3

11. Follow Figure 4 and sew the (16) assorted 3" squares together to make (1) 10 1/2" pieced block. Repeat to make a second pieced block.

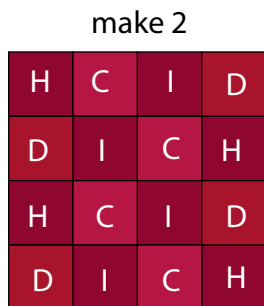

12. Sew the (2) pieced blocks and 92) 10 1/2" Fabric A squares together to make Pillow Top #3 (Fig. 5).

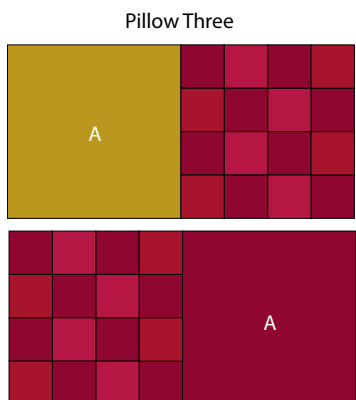

13. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 20 1/2" edge approximately 1/4", press and repeat to make a finished edge on one edge of the 14" x 20 1/2" Fabric K strip. Repeat with the second 14" x 20 1/2" Fabric K strip.

14. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front. Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow (Fig. 2).

15. Turn the pillow right side out.

16. Insert the pillow form.

Sewing Instructions

Pillow #4

17. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the 20 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make (1) A block (Fig. 6).

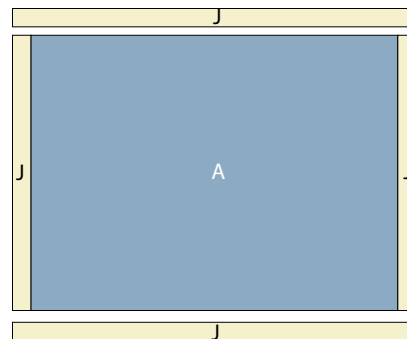

18. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 17 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the A block. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 28 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A block to make Pillow Top #4 (Fig. 7).

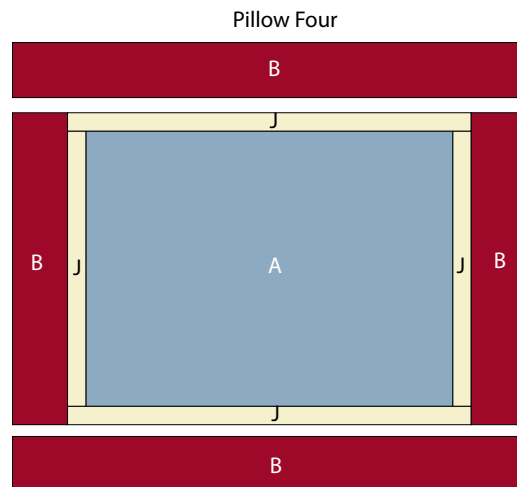

19. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 18" edge approximately 1/4", press and repeat to make a finished edge on one edge of the 18" x 23 1/2" Fabric K strip. Repeat with the second 18" x 23 1/2" Fabric K strip.

20. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front. Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow (Fig. 2).

21. Turn the pillow right side out.

22. Insert the pillow form.
