

Big Splash Free Pattern Pieced Option

Fabric Requirements:

7/8 yard Blue Swirls 6828-11
1 1/4 yards Chevron - Multi (B) 6825-16
2 1/4 yards Seahorse - Cream/Blue (C) 6831-19
1/2 yard Modern Melody Basics - Chili (D) 1063-83
1 Fat Quarter Swirls - Gray (E) 6828-90
1 Fat Quarter Crabs - Yellow (F) 6824-44
1 1/4 yards Sea-Life Patchwork - Multi (G) 6823-16
1 Fat Quarter Submarine - Teal (H) 6826-77
1/3 yard Crabs - Green (I) 6824-66
1/2 yard Fish - Green (J) 6830-66
1/3 yard Bubbles - Orange (K) 6829-33
1 Fat Quarter Fish - Red (L) 6830-88
1 Fat Quarter Bubbles - Gray (M) 6829-90
1 Fat Quarter Modern Melody Basic - Marigold (N) 1063-48
1 Fat Quarter Modern Melody Basic - Spring Green (O) 1063-66
2 1/2 yards Sea-Life Allover - Blue (P) 6827-11
1 Fat Quarter Modern Melody Basic - Orange (Q) 1063-34
1 - 10" square Modern Melody Basic - Pigment White (R) 1063-01W
1 - 10" square Modern Melody Basic - Black (S) 1063-99
5 1/2 yard backing

This addition to the Big Splash pattern is for those that would like to piece the main body of the quilt, rather than the panel squares to the center of the colored blocks it as shown in the PDF version on the Henry Glass website. You will still need to print the original pattern that is given on the Henry Glass website, along with this addition.

Cutting Instructions for Big Splash Free pattern:

From the Swirls - Blue (A), cut:

1 - 15" x 26 1/2" rectangle
10 - 3 1/4" x 9" and 10 - 3" x 4"
See Instructions to cut 4 sets of starfish bubbles

From the Chevron - Multi (B), cut:

9 - 2 1/4" wide lengthwise strips for the binding, fusing cutting the strips so the chevron detail is centered within each strip.
2 - 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips lengthwise and 2 - 2 1/2" x 19" lengthwise strips, centering the chevron detail within each strip.

From the Seahorse cream/blue fabric (C), cut:

4 - 78 1/2" x 2" lengthwise strips
Enough crosswise strips at 2" wide to total 2 lengths at 62" (piecing as needed)
4 - 7 1/4" x 19" strips
4 - 9 1/2" x 7
12 - 9" x 2"
10 - 2" x 19"
12 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Modern Melody Basics - Chili (D): See instructions to cut 1 octopus

From the Swirls - Grey (E), cut:

4 - 3 1/4" x 9" and 4 - 3" x 4"
See Instructions to cut (1) set of Octopus bubbles

From the Crabs - Yellow (F), cut: 4 - 3 1/4" x 8" and 4 - 2 3/4" x 9 1/2"

From the Sea-Life Patchwork - Multi (G), cut: 12 - squares, 12 - vertical rectangles and 4 horizontal rectangles

From the Submarine - Teal (H), cut: 6 - 3¼" x 9" and 6 - 3" x 4"

From the Crabs - Green (I), cut: 10 - 3¼" x 9" and 10 - 3" x 6"

From the Fish - Green (J), cut: 10 - 3¼" x 9" and 10 - 6" x 3" (this print is directional)

From the Bubbles - Orange (K), cut: 8 - 3¼" x 9" and 8 - 3" x 6"

From the Red Fish - (L), cut: 4 - 3¼" x 9" and 4 - 4" x 3" (this print is directional)

From the Bubbles - Gray (M), cut: 4 - 2¾" x 9½" and 4 - 3¼" x 8"

The rest of the cutting is the same as listed in the main pattern.

Sewing Instructions:

Follow Steps 1-5 as listed in the main pattern.

Step 6: Sew a 3¼" x 8" fabric M strip to the top and bottom of 4" x 8" panel strip but from Fabric G. Sew a 2¾" x 9½" fabric M strip to the sides as shown. Make a total of 2 blocks. They should measure 9½" x 12½".

Unit 1, using fabric M - Make 2



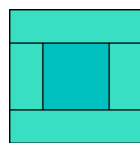
Step 7: Repeat Step 6, this time using the diagrams below for fabric identification to make the designated number of units. When the blocks are finished, you will need to trim/proof to the size listed with each block diagram.

***Please note that the center piece (G) has some variation in size and the pieces bordering it are cut to accommodate the largest sizes. If your block center is smaller in length then the strips being sewn on, you can trim the strips as you go.*

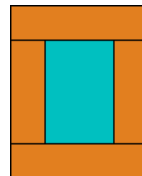
Unit 2, using fabric F

Proof to 9½" x 12½"



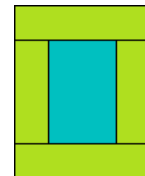
Unit 3, using fabric A

Proof to 9"



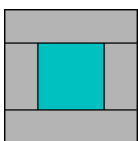
Unit 4, using Fabric K

Proof to 9" x 11"



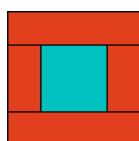
Unit 5, using Fabric J

Proof to 9" x 11"



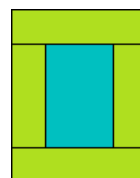
Unit 6, using fabric E

Proof to 9"



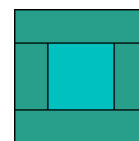
Unit 7, using fabric L
