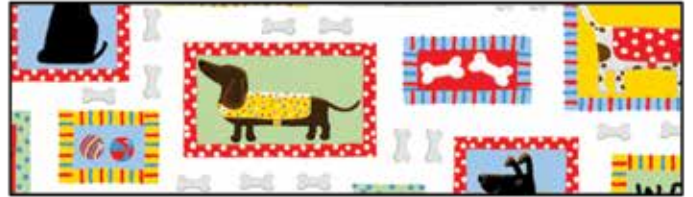

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Dog Treats - Gray (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (3) 3 ¼" squares. Cut (3) 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (12) small triangles. *Note: Only (10) triangles are used.*
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 ⅞" squares. Cut (5) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (10) large triangles.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 2 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 1 ½" squares and (10) 1" x 2" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Allover Dogs - Red (B), cut:

- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 8 ½" strips, (2) 3 ¼" square, (3) 2 ½" squares and (3) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips. Cut the 3 ¼" square across both diagonals to make (8) triangles. *Note: Only (6) triangles will be used.*

From the Toys - Black (C), cut:

- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (20) large triangles.
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) small triangles.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 ½" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (20) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (14) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Dark Gray (E), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (3) 3 ¼" squares. Cut (3) 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (12) small triangles. *Note: Only (10) triangles are used.*
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 ⅞" squares. Cut (5) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (10) large triangles.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 2 ½" strips and (10) 1" squares.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 1 ½" squares and (10) 1" x 2" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (10) eyes.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Camel (F), cut:

- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 1" squares.
- See instructions to cut (10) eyes.

From the Words - Yellow (G), cut:

- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ¼" squares, (3) 2 ½" squares and (3) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips. Cut the 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (8) triangles. *Note: Only (6) triangles are used.*
- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Paw Prints - Black (H), cut:

- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 ¼" squares, (7) 2 ½" squares and (7) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips. Cut the 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (16) triangles. *Note: Only (14) triangles are used.*
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (37) 2 ½" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Allover Dogs - Cobalt Blue (I), cut:

- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Toys - Sky Blue (J), cut:

- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 ½" x 8 ½" strips, (1) 3 ¼" square, (1) 2 ½" square and (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strip. Cut the 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (4) triangles. *Note: Only (2) triangles are used.*

From the Words - Cyan (K), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 ½" x 8 ½" strips, (1) 3 ¼" square, (1) 2 ½" square and (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strip. Cut the 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (4) triangles. *Note: Only (2) triangles are used.*

Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Dog Treats - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3 ¼" squares, (5) 2 ½" squares and (5) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips. Cut the 3 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles.
Note: Only (10) triangles are used.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (M), cut:

- (25) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (49) 2 ½" x 14 ½" strips.

From the Paw Prints - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 90" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 90" back.

Block Assembly

1. Place (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric A square on top of (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 2 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 blocks (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (10) Unit 1 blocks total. *(Note: One block will be used in Block One and the remaining will be used in Blocks, Three, Six, Eight, Ten, Twelve and Fourteen.)*

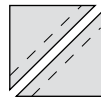

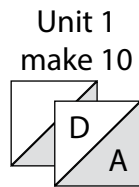

2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric A square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip.

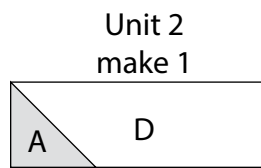

3. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric A strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 6).

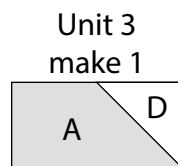

4. Sew (1) Fabric D large triangle, (1) Fabric A small triangle and (1) Fabric B triangle together to make (1) Unit 4 block (Fig. 7).

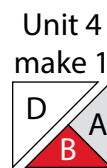

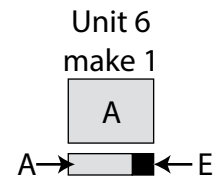

7. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric A square on the top left corner of (1) 5 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 10). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 10). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 11). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

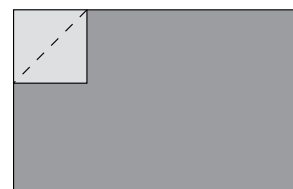

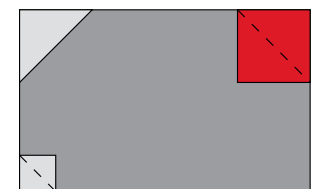

8. Follow Figure 11 for the seam direction to add a 1 ½" Fabric A square to the lower left corner and a 2 ½" Fabric B square to the upper right corner of the 5 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 12).

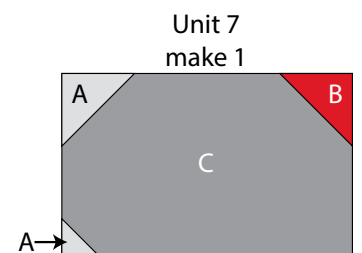

9. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric A square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D strip. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric A strip to each end of (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric B strip. Sew the Fabric B strip to the top of the Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 13).

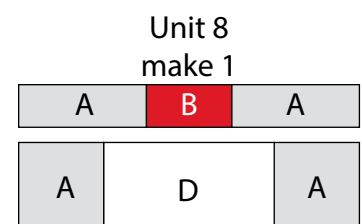

10. Follow Figure 14 and sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 1 block, (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Unit 4 block, (1) Unit 3 strip, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 5 block, (1) Unit 6 block, (1) Unit 8 strip and (1) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric D strip together to make (1) Unit 9 block.

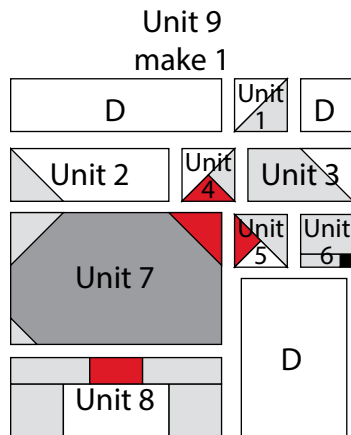

11. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 9 block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 block to make (1) Unit 10 block (Fig. 15).

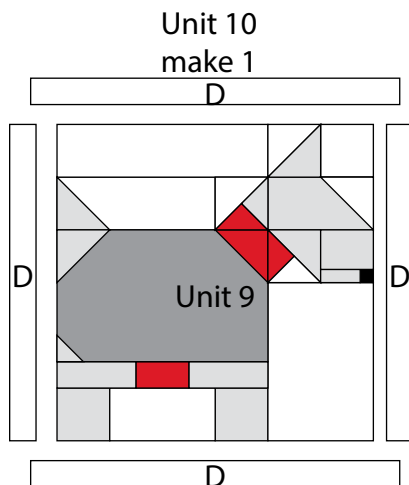

13. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

14. Refer to Figure 16 to arrange and press (1) Fabric E eye onto (1) Unit 10 block.

15. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.

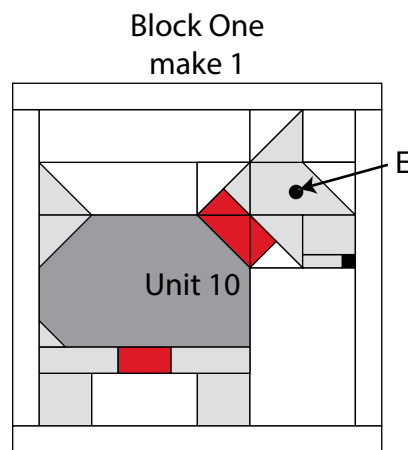

16. Repeat Steps 1-15 and use Figures 17-29 for fabric identification, location, and seam direction to make the designated number of blocks. There are 20 blocks total.

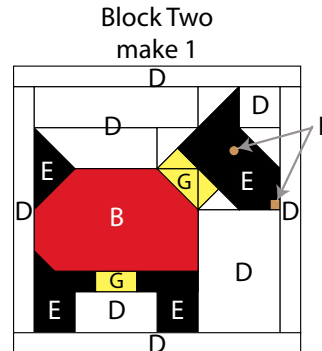

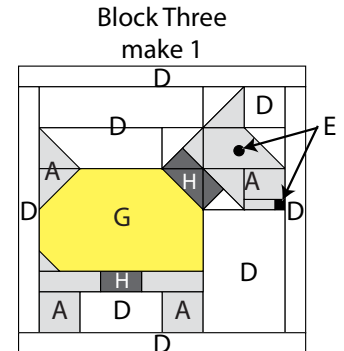

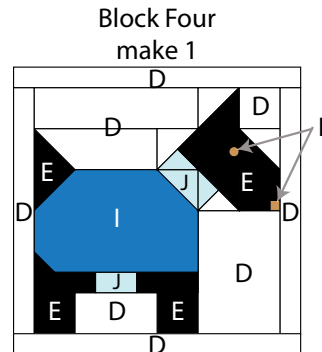

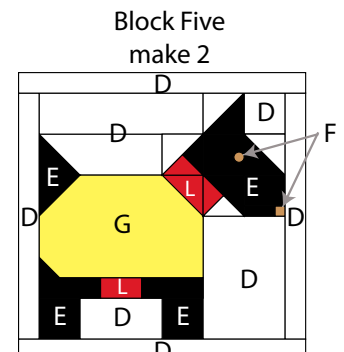

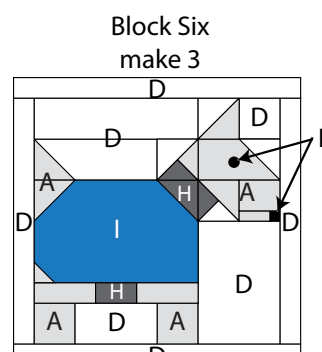

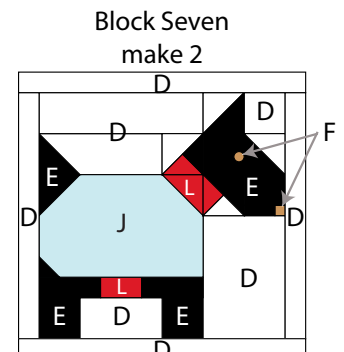

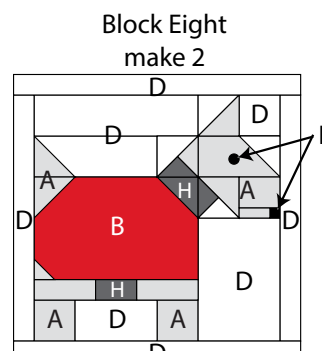

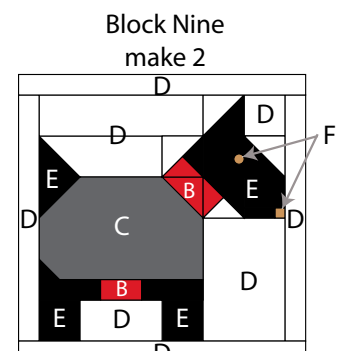

make 1

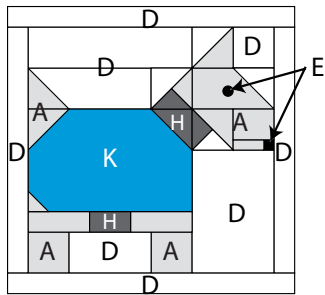

make 1

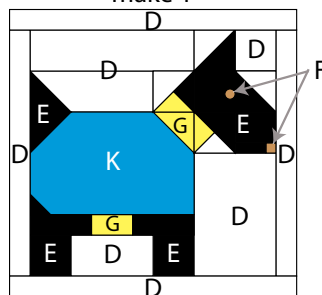

make 1

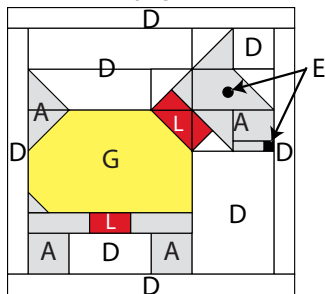

make 1

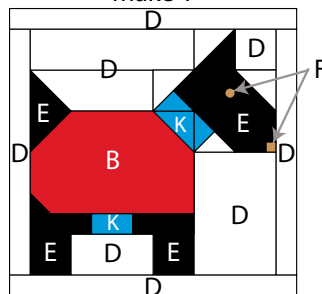

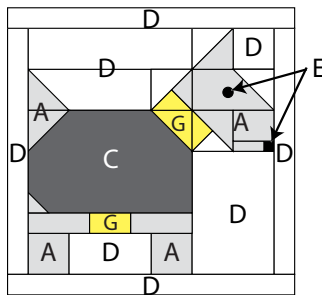

17. Sew (5) 2 1/2" Fabric H squares and (4) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Row (Fig. 30). Repeat to make (6) Sashing Rows total.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

18. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strip, (1) Block Four square and (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row One.

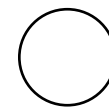
19. Repeat Step 18 using the Blocks as shown in the quilt layout to make Rows 2-5.

20. Sew the (6) Sashing Rows and (5) pieced rows together to make the quilt top.

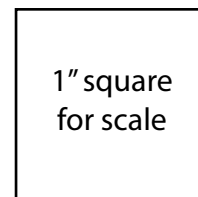
21. Layer and quilt as desired.

22. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

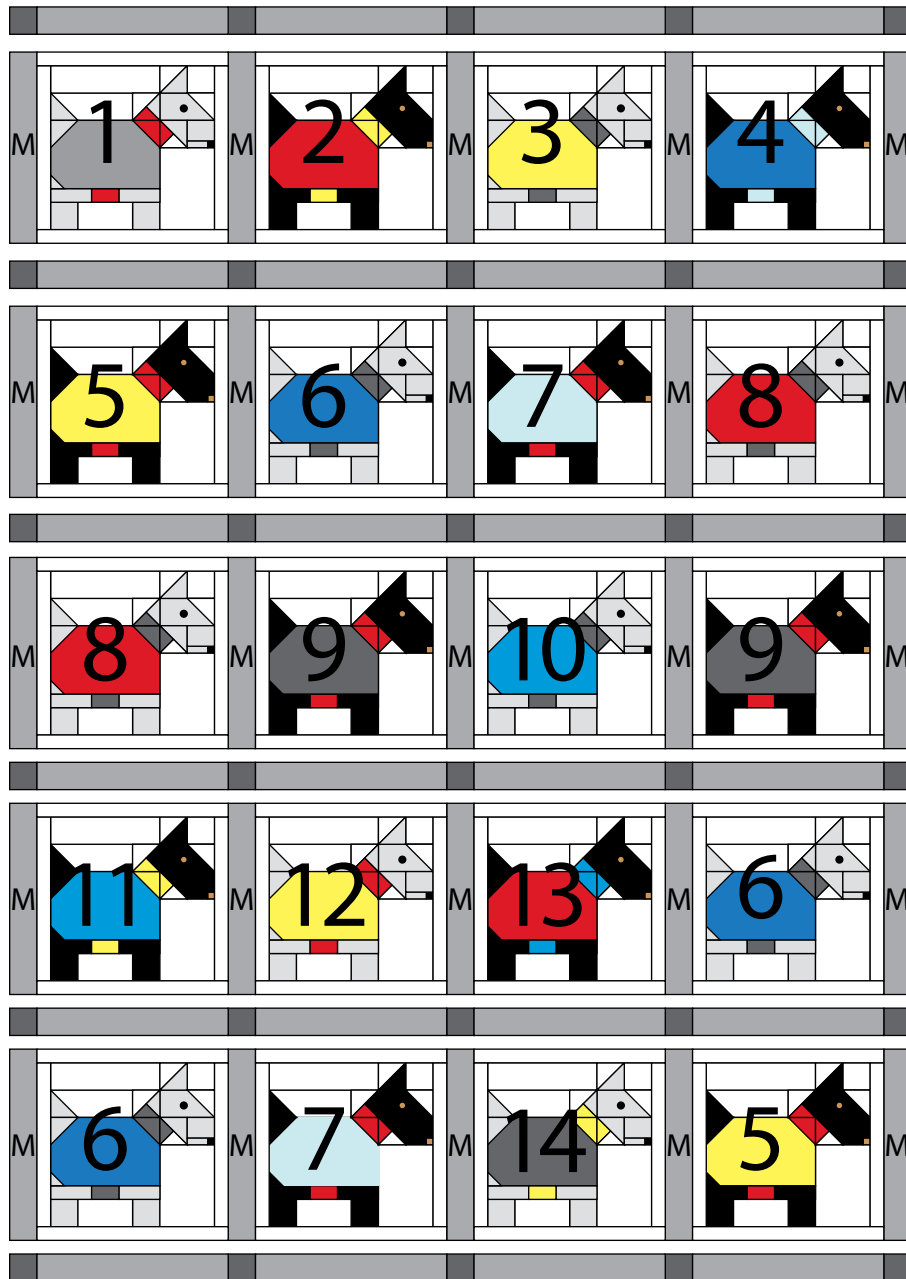
23. Bind as desired.
