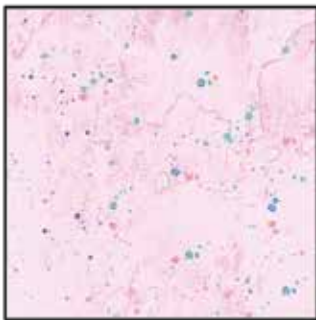

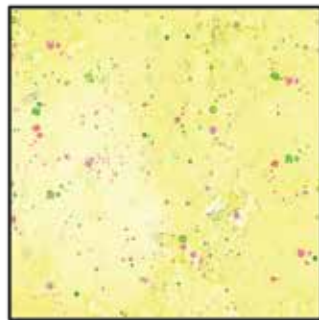

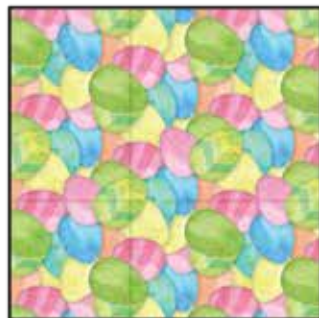

Materials

1 panel	Bunny Panel - Multi (A)	1369P-11
$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	Woven Plaid - Multi (B)	1371-12*
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Texture - Pink (C)	1374-22
$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	Novelty Easter Stripe - Multi (D)	1376-11
$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	Texture - Blue (E)	1374-11
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Bunnies and Eggs - Green (F)	1373-66
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Texture - Yellow (G)	1374-44
3 yards	Easter Words - Multi (Backing)	1372-12

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Bunny Panel - Multi (A), cut:

- (1) $20\frac{3}{4}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " main panel.
- (6) $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" small animal panels.

From the Woven Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x $25\frac{3}{4}$ " WOF strips.
- (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Texture - Pink (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Novelty Easter Stripe - Multi (D):

- Fussy cut (4) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- Fussy cut (4) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.

From the Texture - Blue (E), cut:

- (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $46\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Bunnies and Eggs - Green (F), cut:

- (1) $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" strips.

From the Texture - Yellow (G), cut:

- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x 7" strips.
- (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Easter Words - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 50" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 50" x 56" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 3" x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $20\frac{3}{4}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A main panel. Sew (1) 3" x $25\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ ".

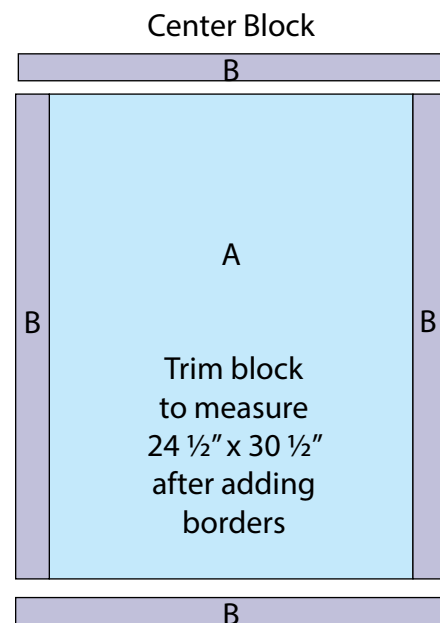

2. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make (1) Block One (Fig. 2). Trim block to measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (6) Block Ones total.

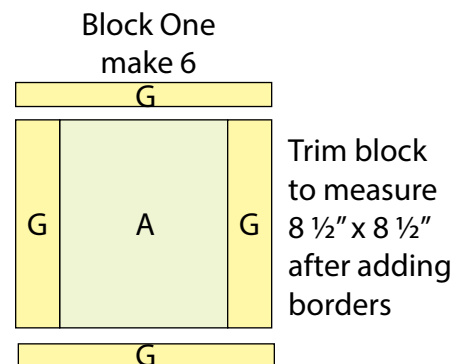

3. Sew (1) $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x 7" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" Fabric F strip. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F strip to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two.

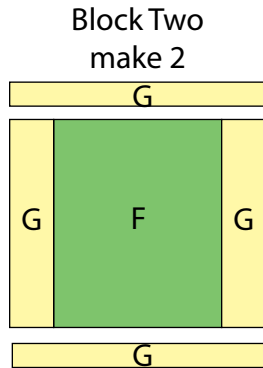

4. Sew (1) 2" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block Threes total.

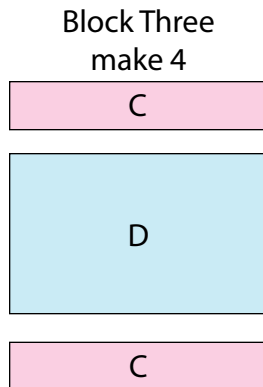

5. Sew (1) 2" x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make (1) Block Four (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Block Fours total.

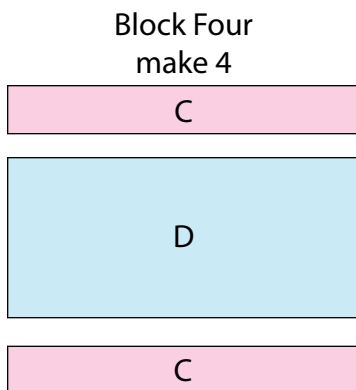

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

6. Sew (1) Block Four to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Two to make (1) side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew (1) side border to each side of the Center Block.

7. Sew together (3) Block Ones [we used (1) duckling, (1) chick and (1) bunny] and (2) Block Threes, alternating them, to make (1) top border strip. Repeat to make (1) bottom border strip. Sew the resulting border strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $46\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

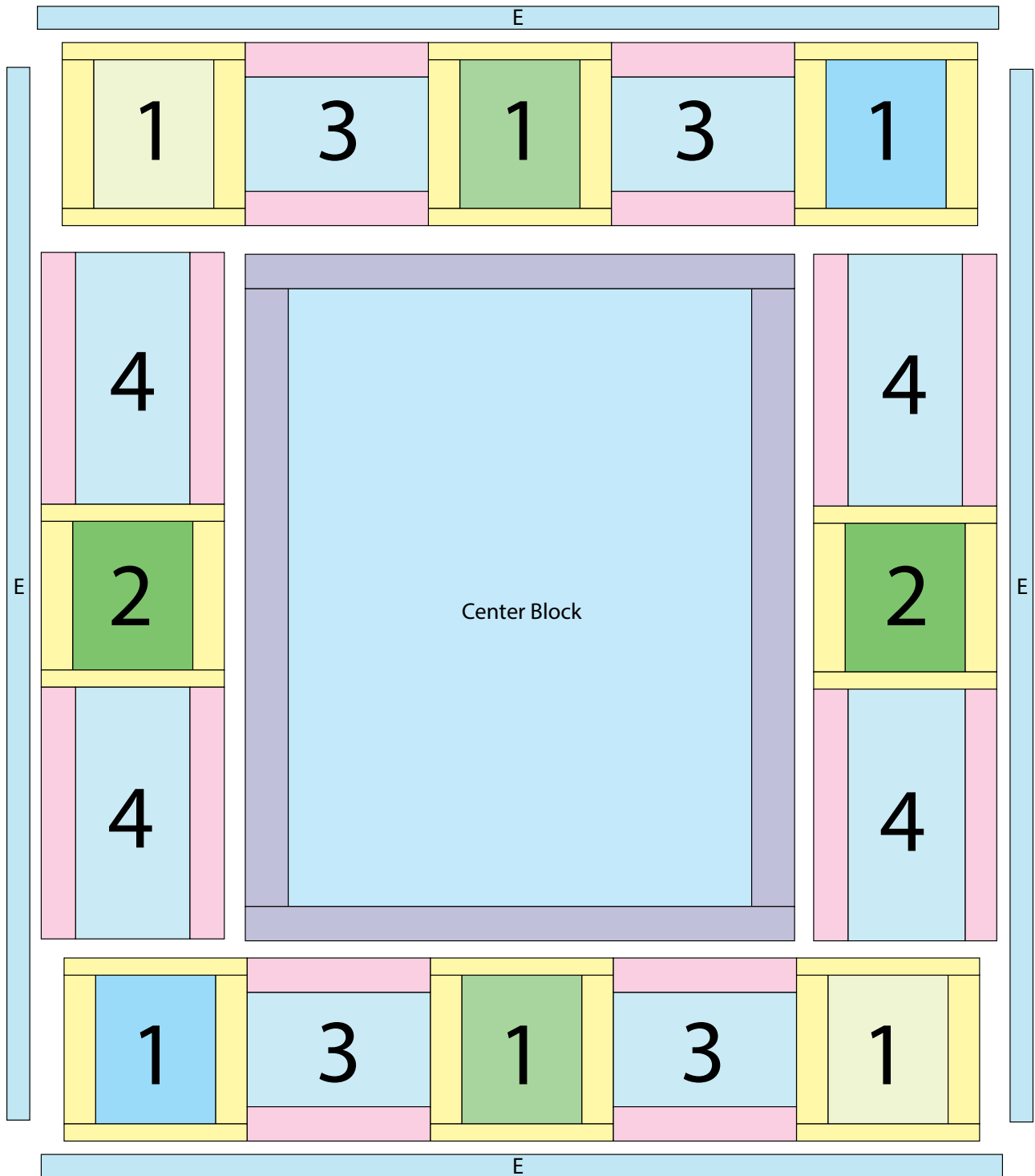
9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.
