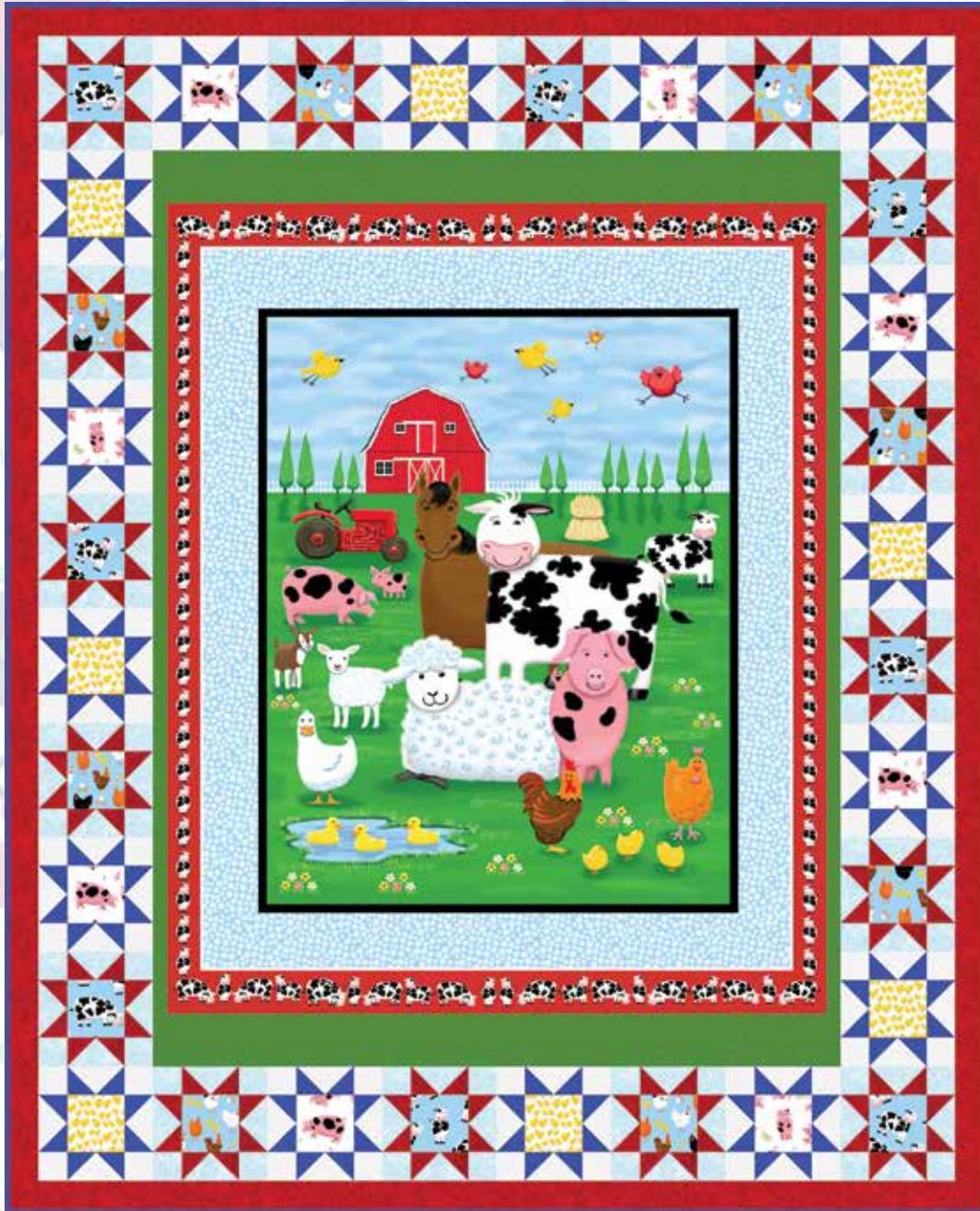

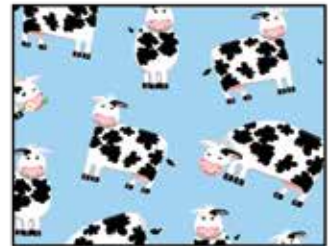

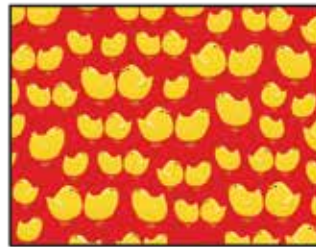

¼ yard	Cows - Blue (C)	1183-11
¼ yard	Pigs - White/Pink (D)	1182-12
¼ yard	Hens & Eggs - Blue (E)	1188-11
¼ yard	Little Chicks - White/Yellow (F)	1184-14
1 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Royal (G)	1063-75*
1 yard	Folio - Red Hot (H)	7755-81
¾ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (I)	1063-01W
¾ yard	Folio - Powder Blue (J)	7755-07
4 yards	Mini Tractors - White/Multi (Backing)	1186-16

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the 36" Farm Panel - Multi/Blue (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 35" x 43" panel.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Grass Green (B), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 43" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 37" WOF strips.

From the Cows - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Pigs - White/Pink (D), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Hens & Eggs - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Little Chicks - White/Yellow (F), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Royal (G), cut:

- (7) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (128) 2" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio - Red Hot (H), cut:

- (7) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (128) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (I), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" squares.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Powder Blue (J), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" squares.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Mini Tractors - White/Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 71" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 59" x 71" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 35" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 37" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 36 ½" x 48 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

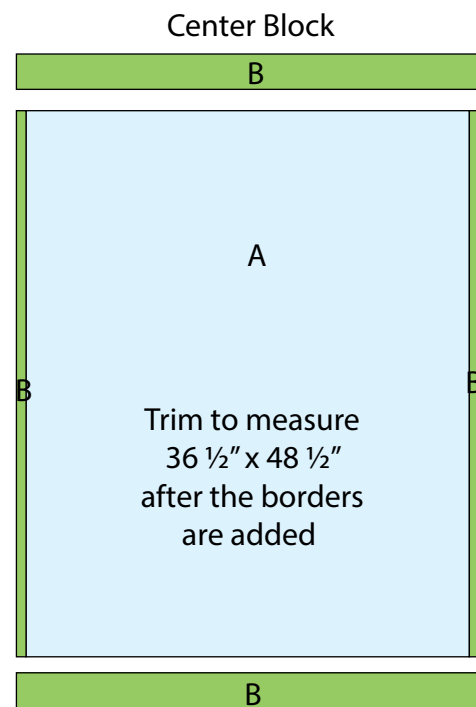

2. Place (1) 2" Fabric H square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

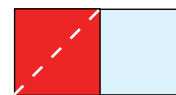

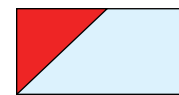
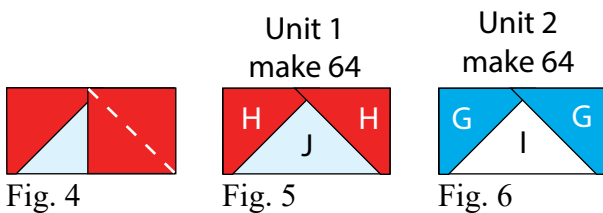

3. Place another 2" Fabric H square on the right side of the 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).

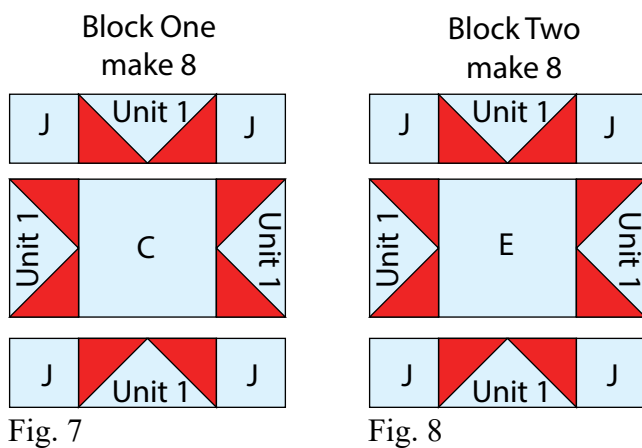
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (64) Unit 1 strips total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (64) 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric I strips and (128) 2" Fabric G squares to make (64) Unit 2 strips (Fig. 6).



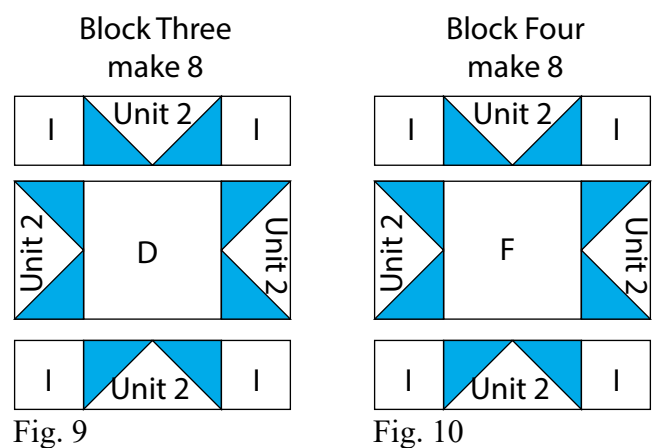
6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric J square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.

7. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric J square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Block Two squares total.



8. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric I square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (8) Block Three squares total.

9. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric F square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric I square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (8) Block Four squares total.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

10. Sew (8) assorted blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. Follow the quilt layout for the order of the blocks.

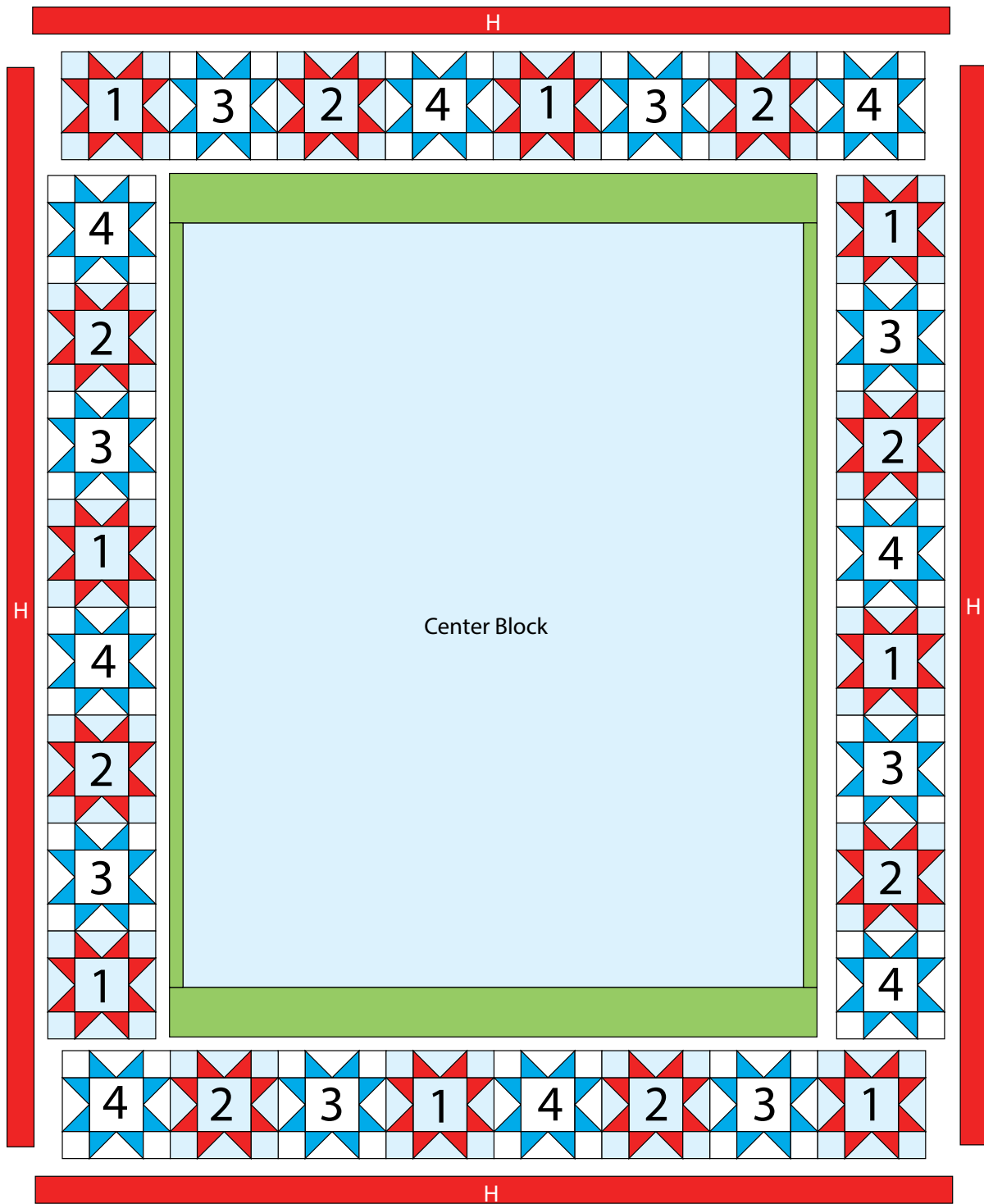
11. Sew (8) assorted blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Follow the quilt layout for the order of the blocks.

12. Sew (1) 2" x 60 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
