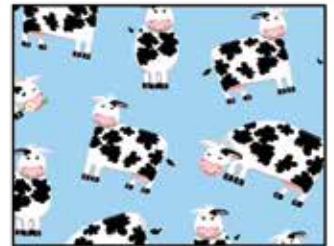

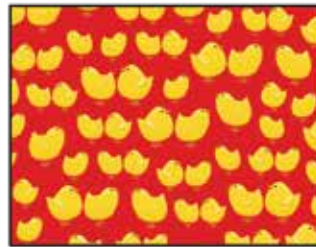

½ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Marigold (B)	1063-48
¼ yard	Pigs - Black (C)	1182-99
¼ yard	Cows - Red (D)	1183-88
¼ yard	Hens & Eggs - Black (E)	1188-99
¼ yard	Little Chicks - Red (F)	1184-88
1 ½ yards	Farm Stripe - White/Multi (G)	1187-16
½ yard	Folio - Red Hot (H)	7755-81*
¾ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (I)	1063-01W
3 yards	Farm Patchwork - Black (Backing)	1185-99

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Farm Scenic - White/Multi (A), cut:

- (1) 22 ½" x 16 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strip.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Marigold (B), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 18 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 22 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.

From the Pigs - Black (C), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Cows - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Hens & Eggs - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Little Chicks - Red (F), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Farm Stripe - White/Multi (G), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 50" LOF strips.
- (2) 4 ½" x 44" LOF strips.

From the Folio - Red Hot (H), cut:

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (6) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 3 ½" squares.

From the Farm Patchwork - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 48" x 54" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric I square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

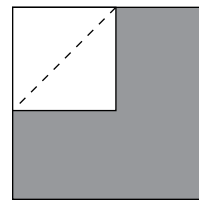

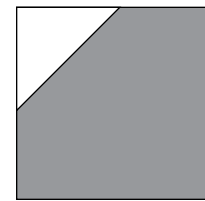

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric I square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (5) Block Ones total.

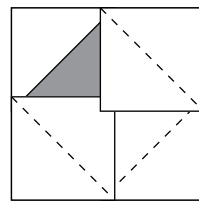

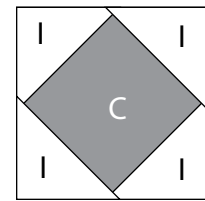

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (4) 6 ½" Fabric E squares and (16) 3 ½" Fabric I squares to make (4) Block Two squares (Fig. 5).
5. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (5) 6 ½" Fabric D squares and (20) 3 ½" Fabric I squares to make (5) Block Three squares (Fig. 6).
6. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (4) 6 ½" Fabric F squares and (16) 3 ½" Fabric I squares to make (4) Block Four squares (Fig. 7).

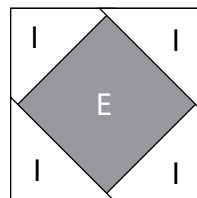

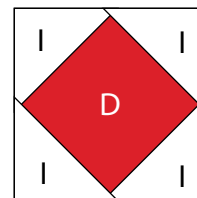

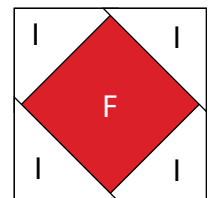

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 16 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block Two square together, in that order. Sew the strip to the left side of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block One square together, in that order. Sew the strip to the right side of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block One square together, in that order. Sew the strip to the top of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Three square together, in that order. Sew the strip to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Center (1) 4 ½" x 50" Fabric G strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

14. Repeat Step 13 to sew (1) 4 ½" x 44" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 8).

15. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 8), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

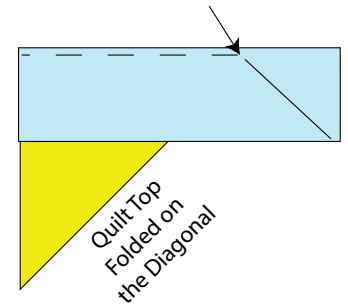
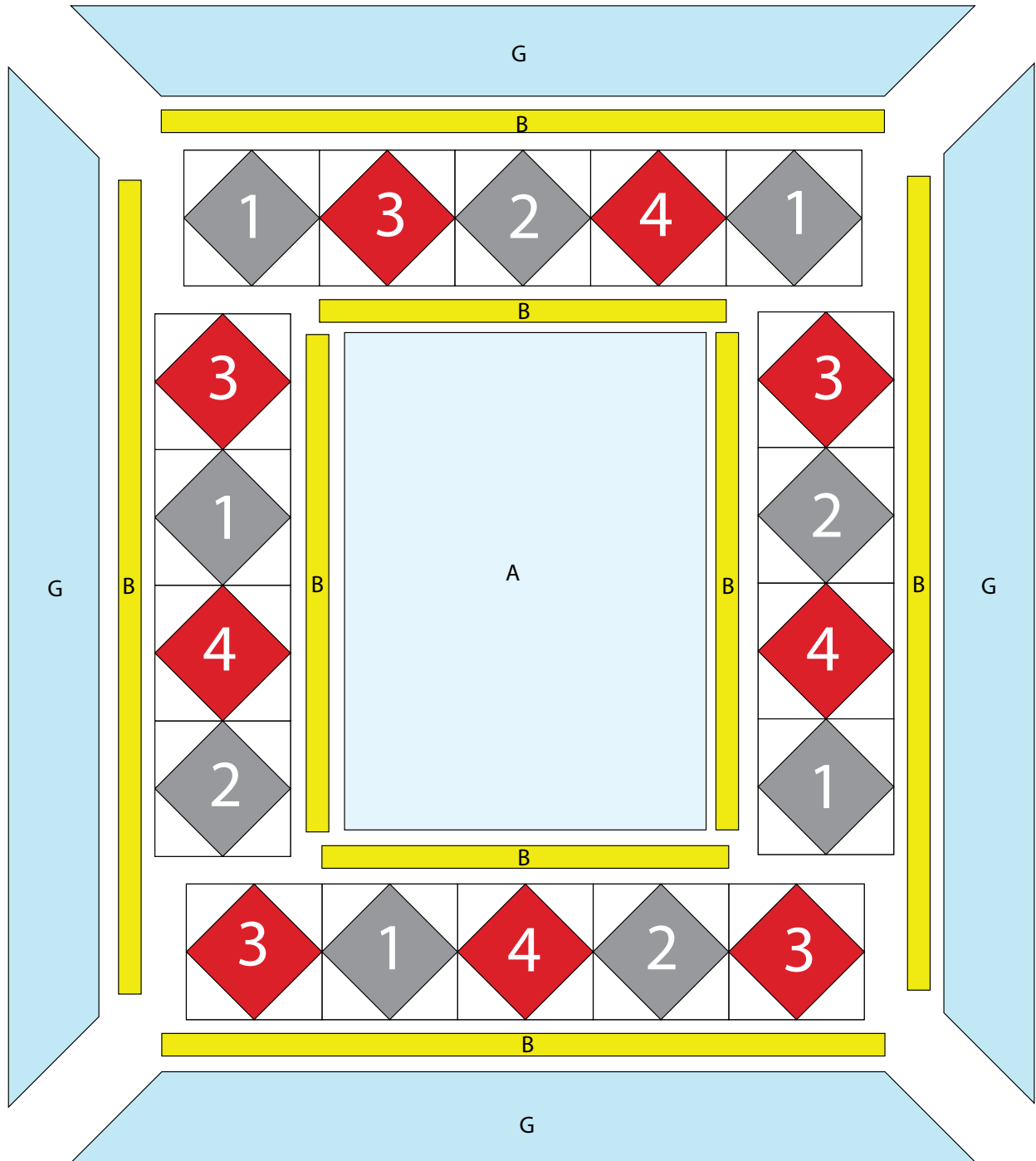

16. Layer and quilt as desired.
17. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
18. Bind as desired.
