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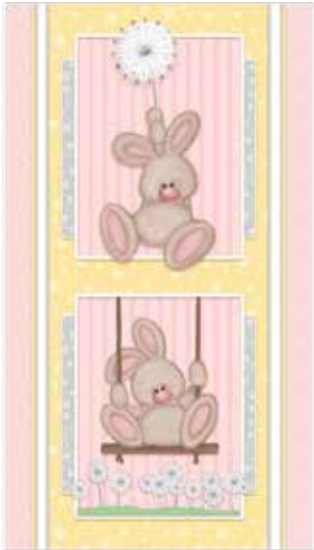

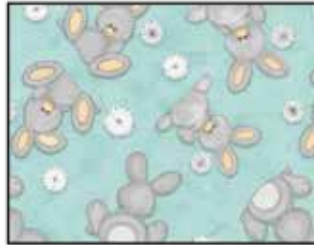

1/4 yard	Fluffy Solid - White (F)	Fluffy Solid White
3/8 yard	Plaid - Blue (G)	F6898-1
1 1/4 yards	Novelty Stripe - Blue (H)	F6894-11

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Pink Version fabrics are listed second in ( ) where different.

#### From the Bunny Squares - Blue

##### (Bunny Squares - Pink) (A), fussy cut:

- (5) 9-patch blocks, all the same, 1/4" outside the frames to measure approximately 9 1/2" square.

#### From the Fluffy Solid - Aqua

##### (Fluffy Solid - Pink) (B), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips.

#### From the Tossed Bunnies - Blue

##### (Tossed Bunnies - Pink) (C), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7" squares.
- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Dot - Blue/Yellow

##### (Dot - Pink/Yellow) (D), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Dandelion - Yellow (E), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Fluffy Solid - White (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Plaid - Blue

##### (Plaid - Pink) (G), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Novelty Stripe - Blue

##### (Novelty Stripe - Pink) (H), cut:

- (4) 7" x 40 1/2" Length of Fabric strips.

#### From the Dandelion - Blue

##### (Dandelion - Pink) (I), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

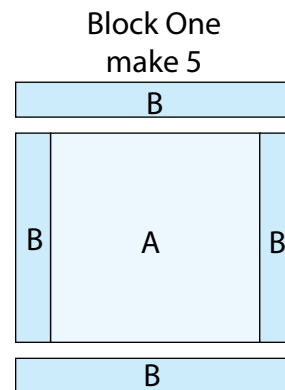
#### From the Plaid - Blue

##### (Plaid - Pink) (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 61" back.

### Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.

2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip together lengthwise to make (1) EF strip set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second EF strip set.

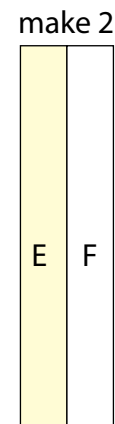

Unit 1 cut 32

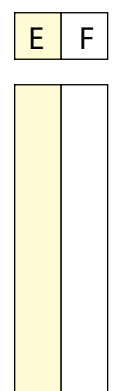

3. Cut the EF strip sets into (32) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 3).

4. Sew (2) Unit 1 strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Unit 2 blocks total.

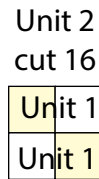

5. Sew (1) Unit 2 block to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric D square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric D square to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.

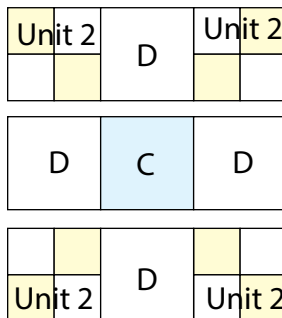

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)*

6. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

7. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two.

8. Sew the (3) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 7" x 40 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 7" Fabric C square to each end of (1) 7" x 40 ½" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

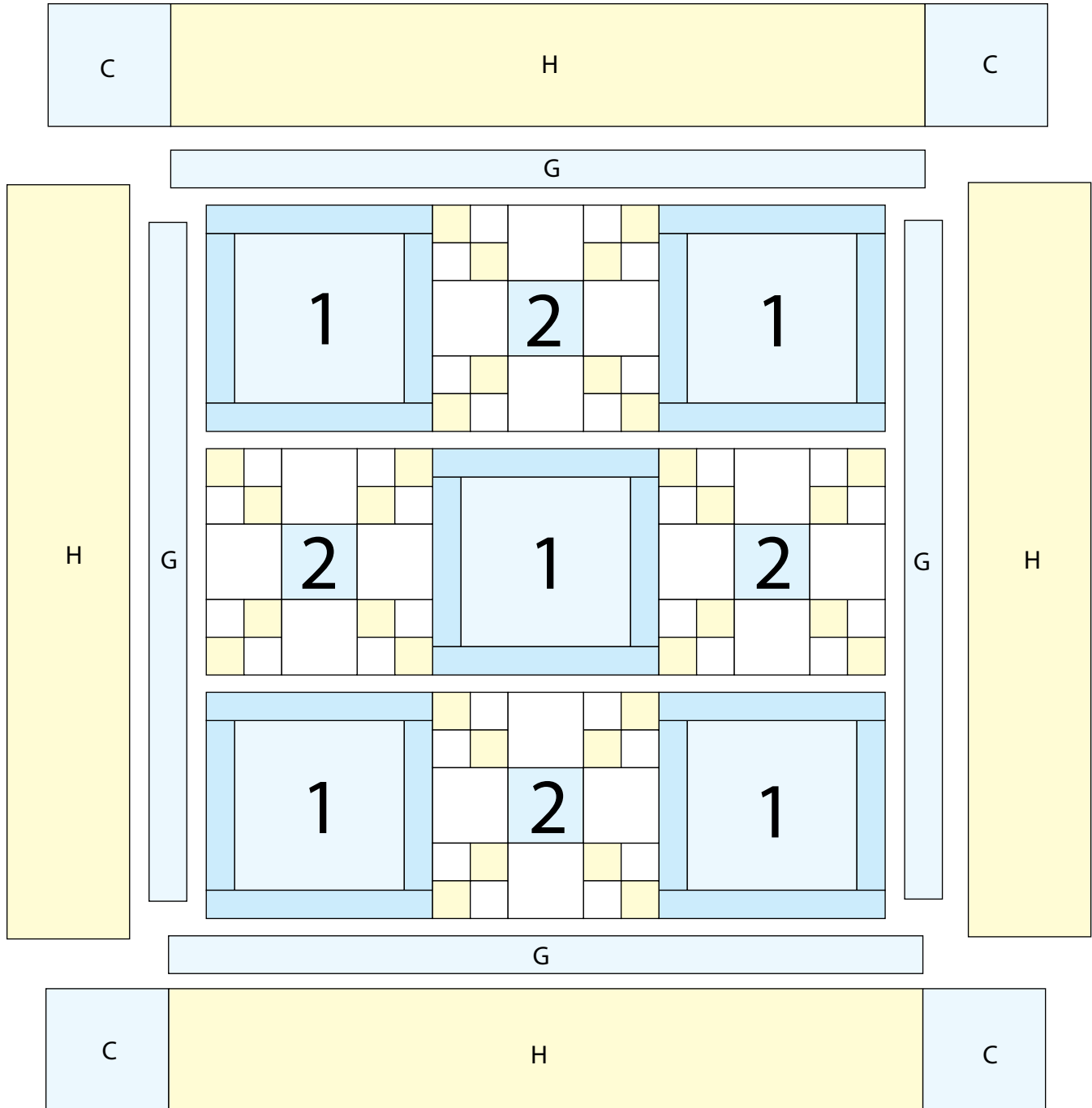
11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
