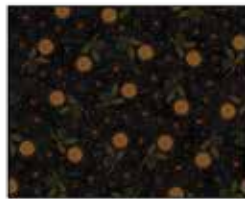

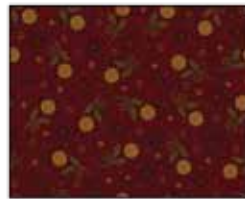

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Words - Cream (A), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 6 ½" squares.

From the Sunflower Chain - Black (B), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ⅞" squares
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the quilt binding.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the bonus runner binding.

From the Border - Black (C), cut:

From the Dots Section:

- (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips from the Length of Fabric (LOF).
- (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips from the LOF.

From the Border Stripe Section:

- (2) 12 ½" x 48 ½" strips from the LOF

From the remaining Dots Section:

- (8) 3 ⅞" squares
- (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips

From the Milkyway - Black (D), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Sunflower - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Dots - Purple (F), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (32) 3 ½" squares.

From the Small Plaid - Red (G), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Moon and Stars - Purple (H), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (32) 3 ½" squares.

From the Sunflower - Cheddar (I), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Stripe - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Window Pane Plaid - Red (K), cut:

- (2) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Dots - Cream (L), cut:

- (2) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Tonal Window Check - Cream (M), cut:

- (2) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Sunflower Chain - Red (N), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Sunflower - Red (O), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Stars - Antique Gold (P), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Dots - Red (Q), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Milkyway - Cheddar (R), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Window Check - Cream (S), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Milkyway - Cream (T), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Stars - Wheat (U), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Words - Red (V), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end using a diagonal seam. Cut (2) 5 ½" x 63 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end using a diagonal seam. Cut (2) 5 ½" x 61 ½" strips.

From the Words - Black (Quilt Backing), cut:

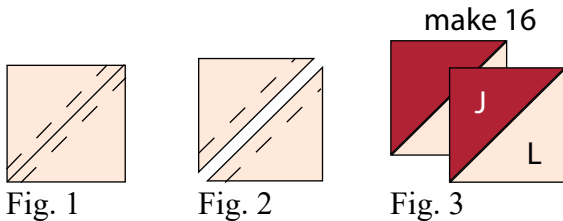
- (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 81" back.

From the Words - Black (Bonus Runner Backing), cut:

- (1) 20" x 56" strip for the backing.

Sewing Instructions

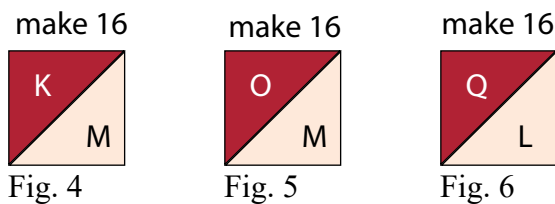
1. Place (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric L square on top of (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric J square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) JL units (Fig. 3). Trim blocks to measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (16) JL units total.



2. Repeat Step 1 with (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric K squares and (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric M squares to make (16) KM units (Fig. 4).

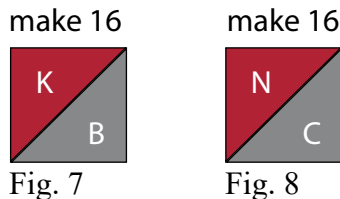
3. Repeat Step 1 with (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric O squares and (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric M squares to make (16) OM units (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Step 1 with (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric Q squares and (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric L squares to make (16) QL units (Fig. 6).

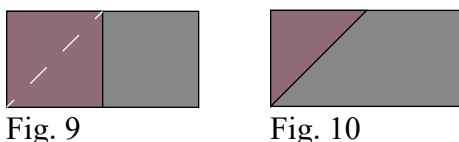


5. Repeat Step 1 with (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric K squares and (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B squares to make (16) KB units (Fig. 7).

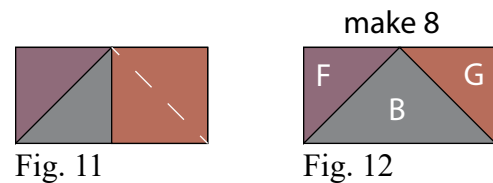
6. Repeat Step 1 with (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N squares and (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C squares to make (16) NC units (Fig. 8).



7. Place (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square on the left side of (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 10). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.



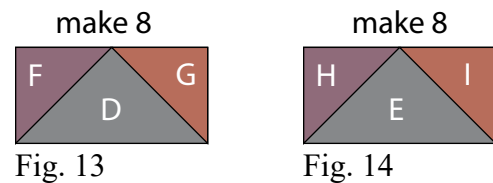
8. Place (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the right side of the $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 12). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) FBG unit.



9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " FBG units.

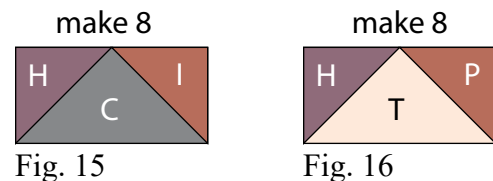
10. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips, (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares and (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares to make (8) FDG units (Fig. 13).

11. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips, (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares to make (8) HEI units (Fig. 14).



12. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strips, (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares to make (8) HCI units (Fig. 15).

13. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric T strips, (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (8) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P squares to make (8) HTP units (Fig. 16).



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14. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric U strips, (8) 3 1/2" Fabric H squares and (8) 3 1/2" Fabric P squares to make (8) HUP units (Fig. 17).

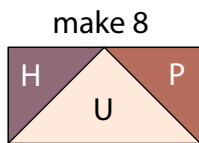

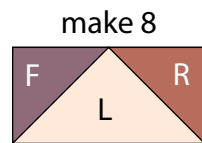

15. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric L strips, (8) 3 1/2" Fabric F squares and (8) 3 1/2" Fabric R squares to make (8) FLR units (Fig. 18).

16. Repeat Steps 7-8 with (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric S strips, (8) 3 1/2" Fabric F squares and (8) 3 1/2" Fabric R squares to make (8) FSR units (Fig. 19).

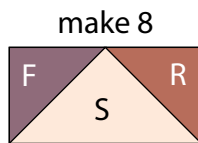

17. Refer to Figure 20 for the block layout to sew together (1) of each unit: 6 1/2" Fabric A square, HCI unit, HEI unit, FBG unit, FDG unit along with (2) of each unit: JL unit and MK unit to make one Block One square. Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total. *Note: Two of the Block Ones are for the Bonus Runner.*

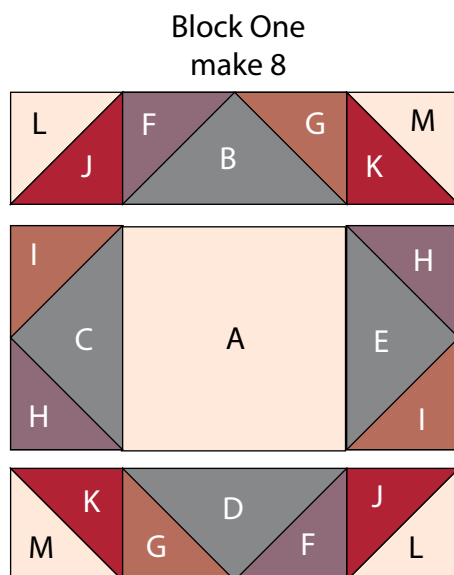

18. Refer to Figure 21 for the block layout to sew together (1) of each unit: FSR unit, FLR unit, HTP unit, HUP unit along with (2) of each unit: QL unit and OM unit, KB unit and NC unit to make one Block Two square. Repeat to make (8) Block Two squares total. *Note: Two of the Block Twos are for the Bonus Runner.*

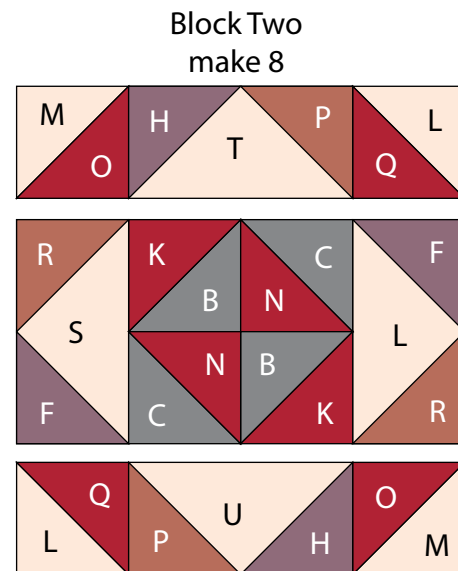

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

19. Sew together (2) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them to make Block Row One, Repeat to make Block Row Two and Three. *Note: Start with Block Two for Row Two.*

20. Refer to the quilt layout to sew the block rows together with (2) 12 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric C strips to make the quilt top. Make sure to rotate Block Row 2 180 degrees

21. Sew (1) 2" x 60 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 51 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

22. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 63 1/2" Fabric V strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 61 1/2" Fabric V strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

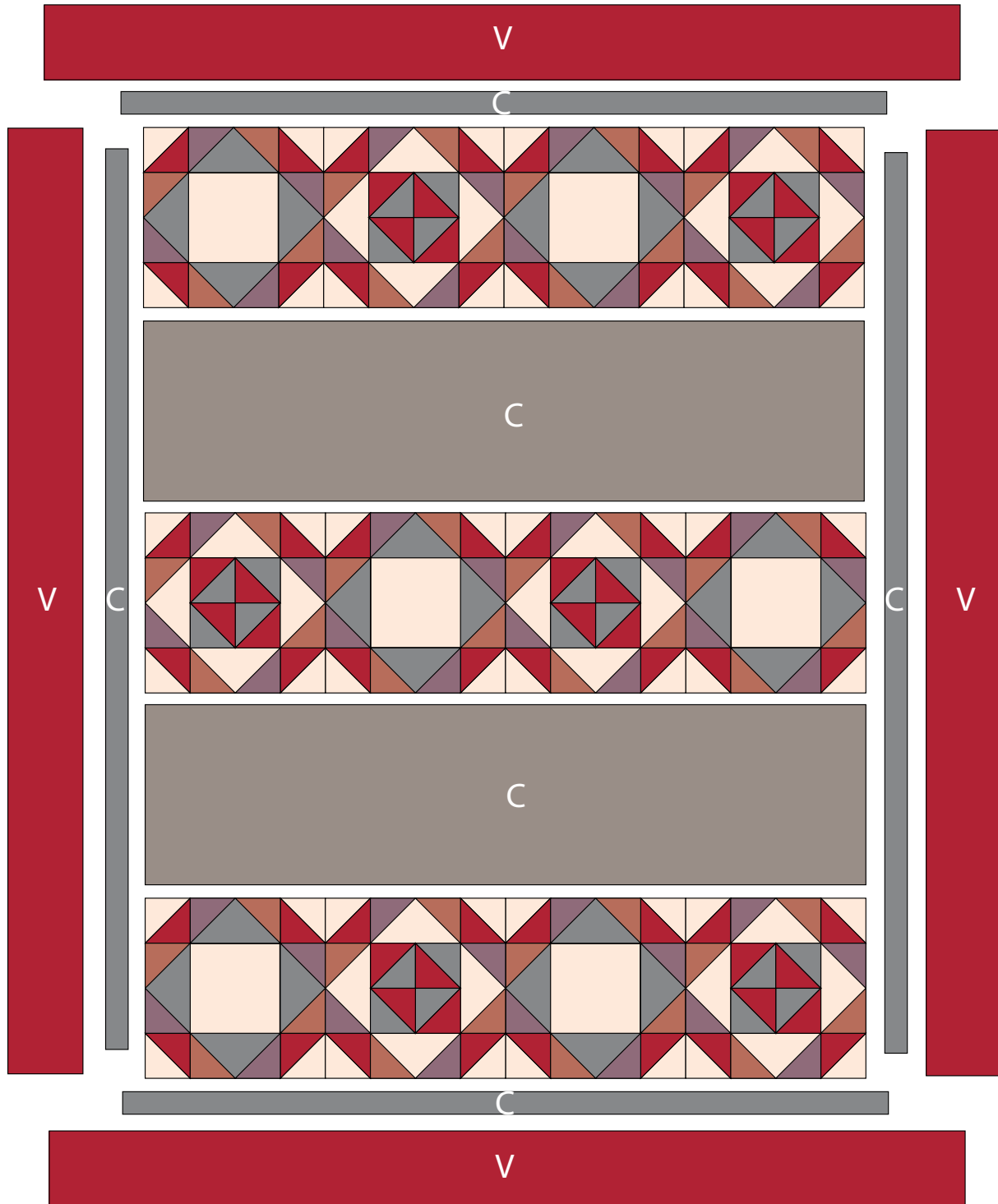
23. Layer and quilt as desired.

24. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

25. Bind as desired.

Quilt Layout

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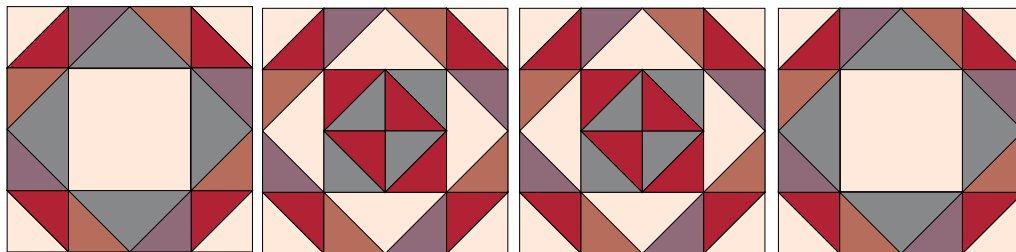

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Bonus Runner Assembly

(Refer to the Bonus Runner Layout while assembling.)

1. Sew together (1) Block One square, (2) Block Two squares and (1) Block One square, in that order to make the runner top.
2. Layer and quilt as desired.
3. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
4. Bind as desired.
