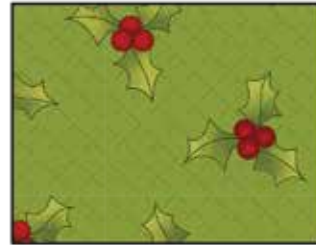

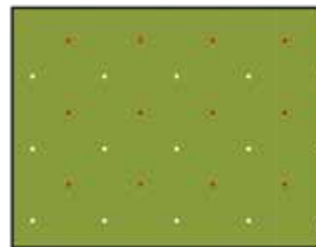

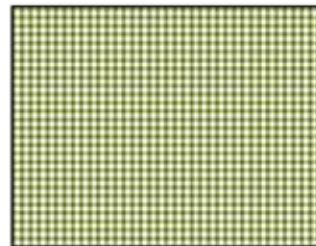

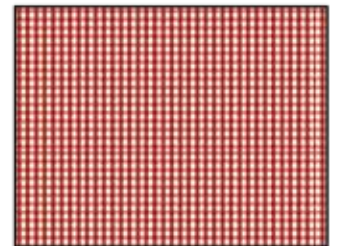

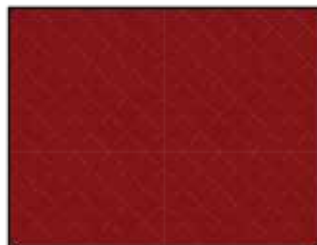

Quilts 1 & 2

Quilt #1 Materials

1 panel	Tree Panel Ring in the Holly Days - Cream (A)	2093P-40
$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Candy Cane Stripe - Cream/Red (B)	2102-48*
$\frac{1}{8}$ yard	Small Dot - Red (C)	2099-88
$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Large Holly - Cream (D)	2095-40
1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards	Large Holly - Cream (Backing)	2095-40

*Includes binding

Quilt #1 Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Tree Panel Ring in the Holly Days - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " panel

From the Candy Cane Stripe - Cream/Red (B), cut:

- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Dot - Red (C), cut:

- (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Large Holly - Cream (D), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Large Holly - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (1) 40" x 42" strip for the back.

Quilt #1 Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to each end of (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to make (1) CBC strip. Repeat to make a second CBC strip. Sew (1) CBC strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1).

Quilt #1 Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 2 while assembling.)

2. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Unit 1 block. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make the quilt top.

3. Layer and quilt as desired.

4. Sew the (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

5. Bind as desired.

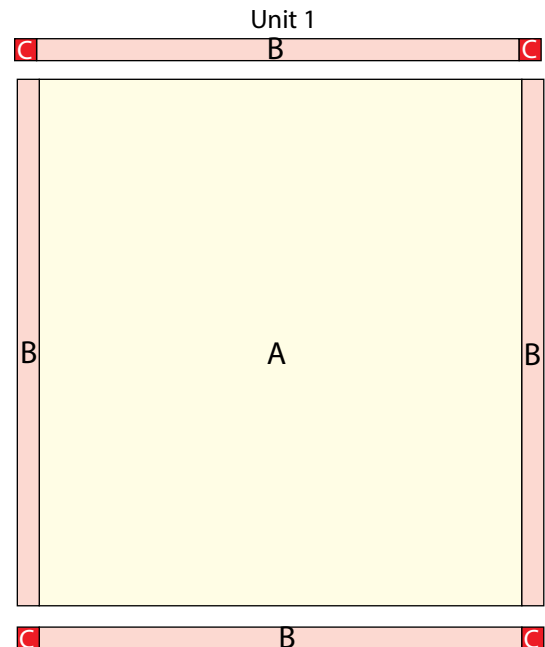

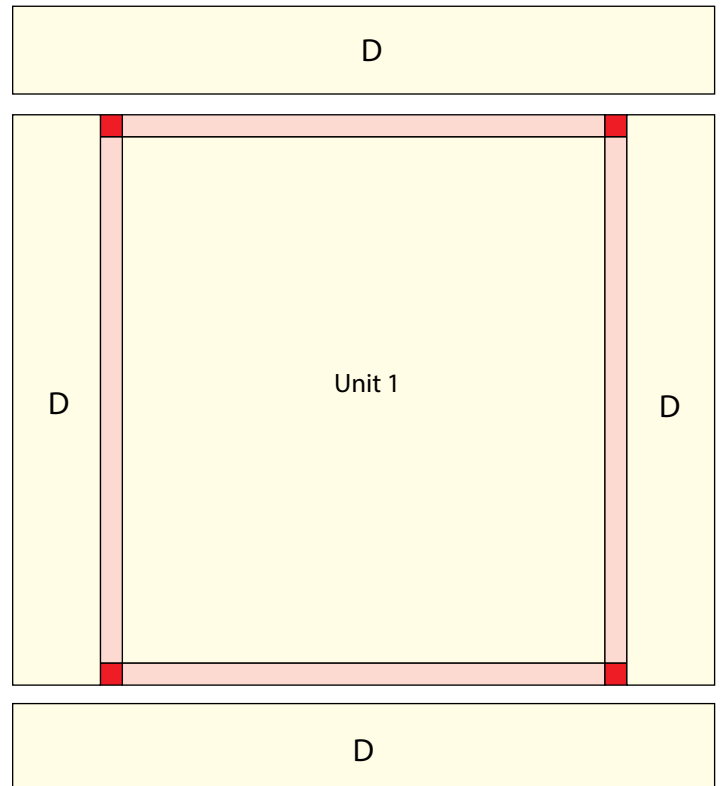

Quilt #2 Materials

1 panel	Tree Panel Ring in the Holly Days - Cream (A)	2093P-40
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Large Dot - Cream (B)	2098-40
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Small Holly - Cream (C)	2096-40
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Large Dot - Red (D)	2098-88
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Candy Cane Stripe - Cream/Red (E)	2102-48*
$1 \frac{1}{3}$ yards	Small Holly - Cream (Backing)	2096-40

*Includes binding

Quilt #2 Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Tree Panel Ring in the Holly Days - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $22 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips each centered on the wreaths.

From the Large Dot - Cream (B), cut:

- (1) 11" x 24" WOF strip.

From the Small Holly - Cream (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x 20" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x $25 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Large Dot - Red (D), cut:

- (2) 3" x 23" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x $30 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Candy Cane Stripe - Cream/Red (E), cut:

- (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Holly - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (1) 36" x 38" WOF strip for the back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Enlarge the embroidery design template 200%.
2. Trace the embroidery design onto the center of the 11" x 24" Fabric B strip.
3. Using your favorite method, hand embroider the design.
4. Trim the embroidered Fabric B strip to measure 10 " x $22 \frac{1}{2}$ " (Fig. 3).

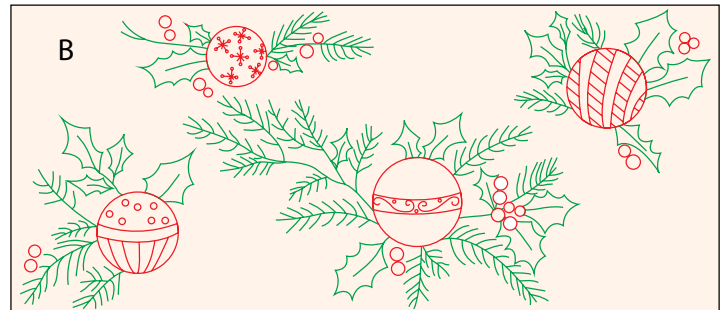

5. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $22 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B strip to make the Center Block (Fig. 4).

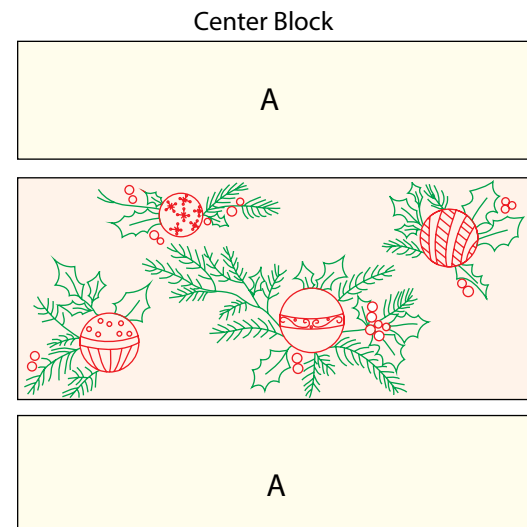

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 5 on Page 4 while assembling.)

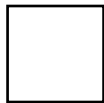
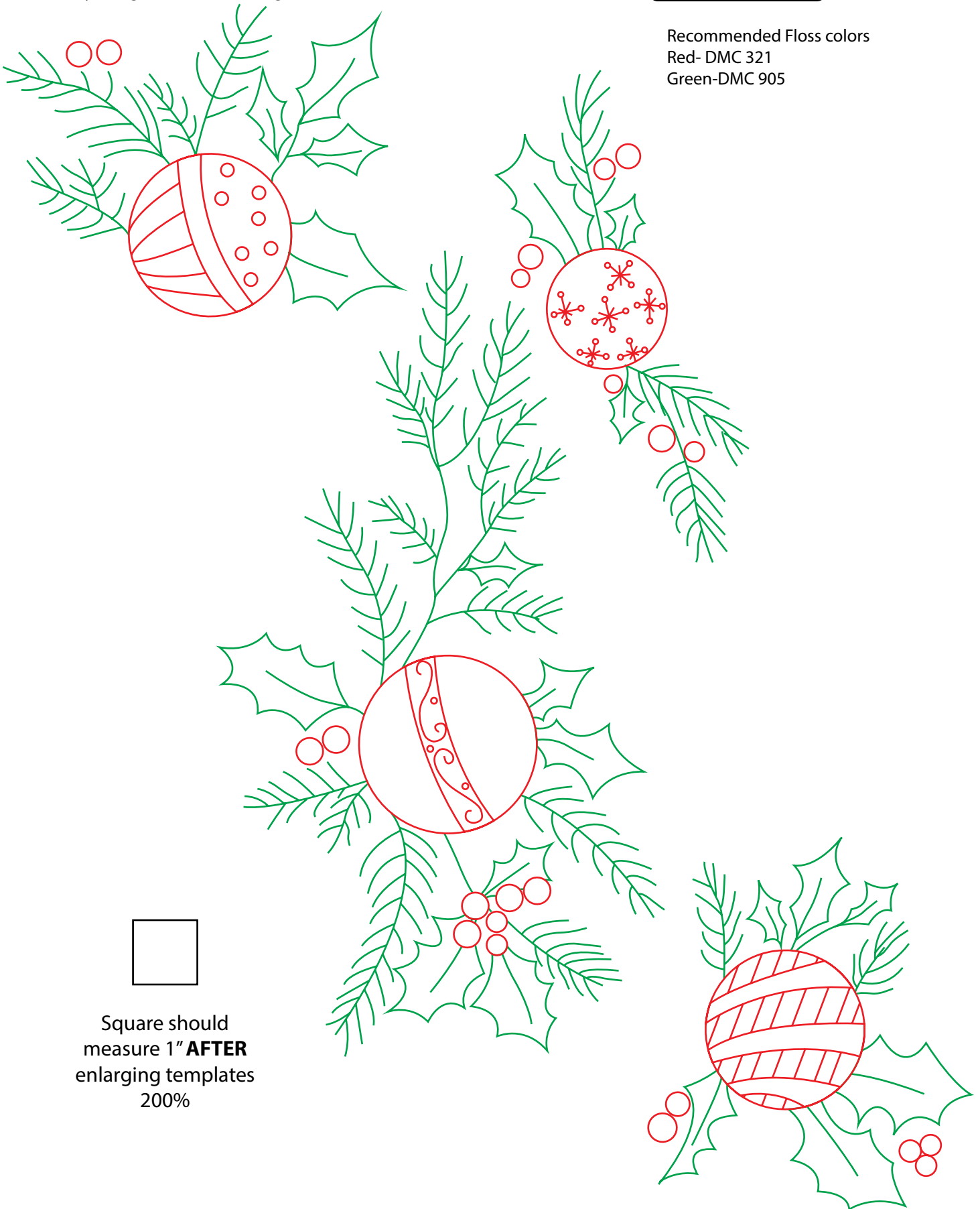
6. Sew (1) 2" x 20" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $25 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) 3" x 23" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x $30 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
8. Layer and quilt as desired.
9. Sew the (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
10. Bind as desired.

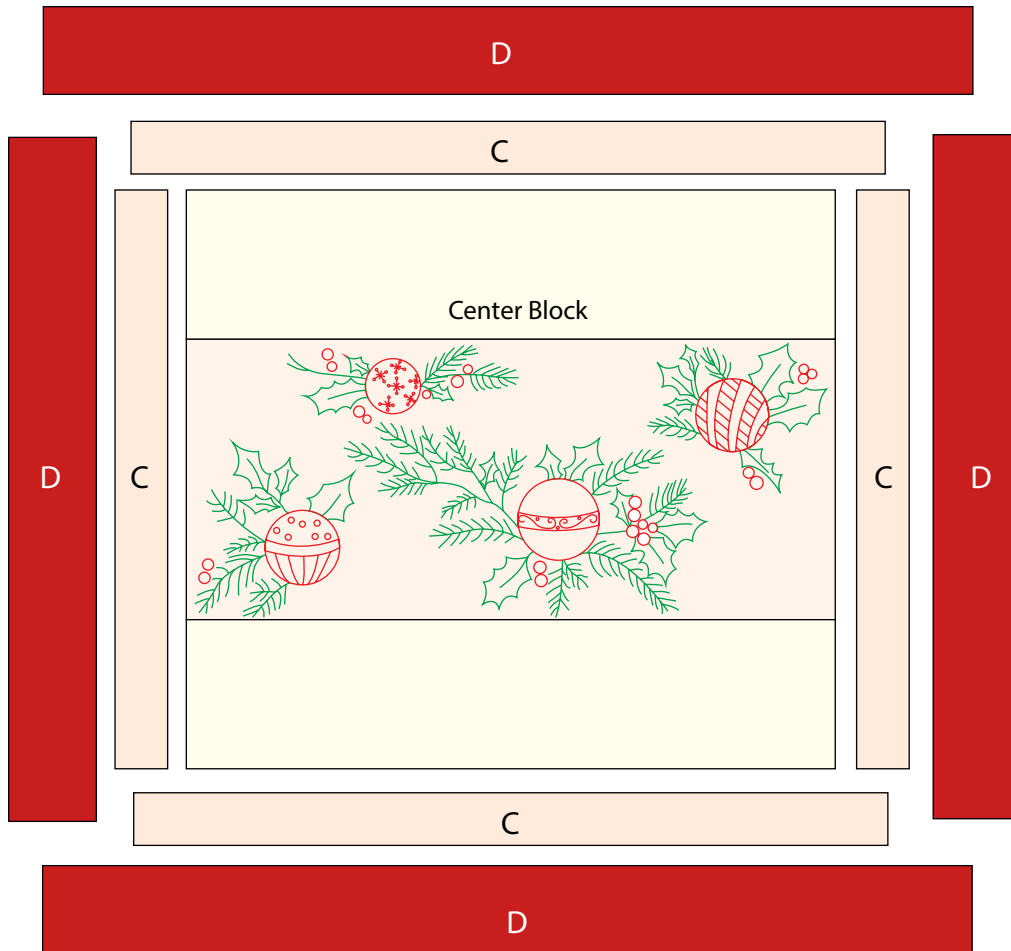
