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Materials for Four Red Large Placemats

5/8 yard	Red Snowflakes <i>(includes binding)</i>	9685-88
1 yard	Red Trees	9686-09
3/8 yard	Red Scroll	9687-88
3/8 yard	White Harlequin	9688-09
3/8 yard	Gray Branches	9690-99
5/8 yard	Gray Tonal <i>(from Folio Basics Collection)</i>	7755-91
2 1/2 yards	Red Trees <i>(for backing)</i>	9686-09

Cutting Instructions for Four Red Large Placemats

Please note: all strips, except for the printed stripe, are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the red snowflakes, cut:

(8) 2 1/4" strips for binding.

From the red trees, cut:

(2) 15 1/2" strips. Recut into (4) 12 1/2" x 15 1/2" piece.

From the red scroll, cut:

(1) 3 1/2" strip. Recut into (4) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces.

(4) 1 1/2" strips. Recut into (8) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" pieces.

From EACH of the white harlequin and gray branches, cut:

(2) 3 1/2" strips. Recut into (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces.

From the gray tonal, cut:

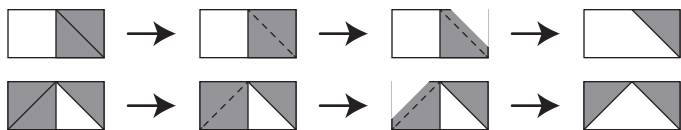
(4) 3 1/2" strips. Recut into (8) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces and

(32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

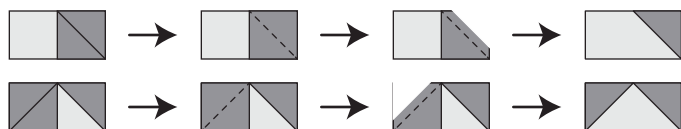
Sewing Instructions for the Red Large Placemats

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3 1/2" gray tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" green branches piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting white triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the green branches piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (8) identical units.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3 1/2" white tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" green scroll piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting white triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the green scroll piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (8) identical units.

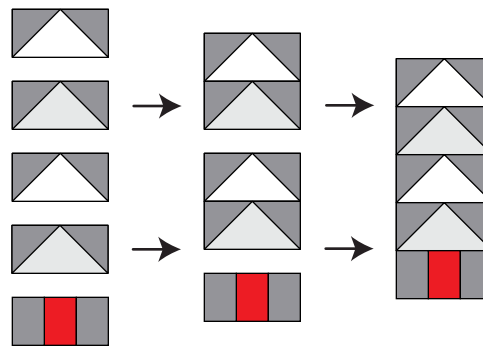


3. Stitch 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" white tonal pieces to each long side of a 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" red scroll piece to yield (1) tree trunk unit measuring 3 1/2" x 6 1/2", from raw edge to raw edge, in both directions. Repeat to

make a total of (4) identical units.



4. Referring to the diagram below, arrange (2) white harlequin flying geese units, (2) gray branches flying geese units, and (1) tree trunk unit, alternating the two types of flying geese units as shown, and placing the tree trunk unit at the base. Stitch the units together to make (1) tree unit measuring 6 1/2" x 15 1/2", from raw edge to raw edge in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



5. Using the placemat pictured on the cover as a guide, stitch 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" red scroll pieces to each long side of a tree unit from step 4. Stitch a 12 1/2" x 15 1/2" red trees piece to the right-hand side to complete the placemat front, noting the orientation of the pieced tree unit and the printed motifs in the red trees fabric. Repeat to make a total of (4) placemat fronts.

6. Layer the completed placemat fronts with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2 1/4" red snowflakes strips.

7/8 yard	Green Scroll <i>(includes binding)</i>	9687-66
3/8 yard	Green Branches	9690-66
5/8 yard	White Tonal <i>(from Folio Basics Collection)</i>	7755-01
2 1/2 yards	Blue Trees <i>(for backing)</i>	9686-01

Cutting Instructions for Four Blue Large Placemats

Please note: all strips, except for the printed stripe, are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the blue trees, cut:

(2) 15 1/2" strips. Recut into (4) 12 1/2" x 15 1/2" piece.

From the blue scroll, cut:

(1) 3 1/2" strip. Recut into (4) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces.

(4) 1 1/2" strip. Recut into (8) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" pieces.

From the green scroll, cut:

(2) 3 1/2" strips. Recut into (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces.

(8) 2 1/4" strips for binding.

From the green branches, cut:

(2) 3 1/2" strips. Recut into (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces.

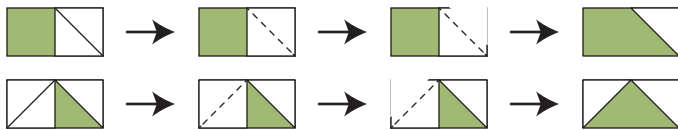
From the white tonal, cut:

(4) 3 1/2" strips. Recut into (8) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces and (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

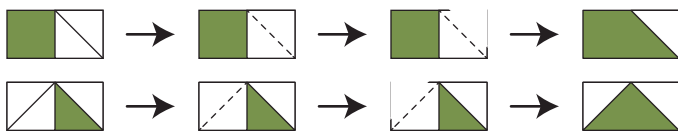
Sewing Instructions for the Blue Large Placemats

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

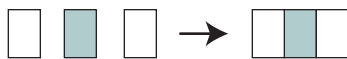
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3½" white tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3½" x 6½" white harlequin piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting gray triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the white harlequin piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (8) identical units.



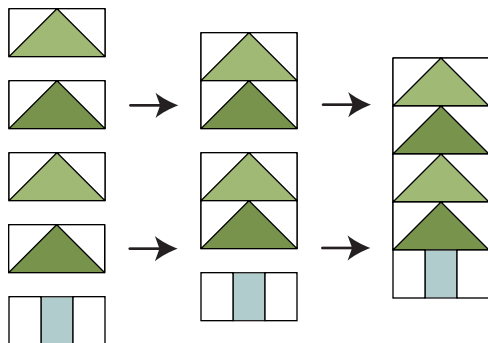
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3½" gray tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3½" x 6½" gray branches piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting gray triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the gray branches piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (8) identical units.



3. Stitch 2½" x 3½" gray tonal pieces to each long side of a 2½" x 3½" blue scroll piece to yield (1) tree trunk unit measuring 3½" x 6½", from raw edge to raw edge, in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



4. Referring to the diagram below, arrange (2) green branches flying geese units, (2) green scroll flying geese units, and (1) tree trunk unit, alternating the two types of flying geese units as shown, and placing the tree trunk unit at the base. Stitch the units together to make (1) tree unit measuring 6½" x 15½", from raw edge to raw edge in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



5. Using the placemat pictured on the cover as a guide, stitch 1½" x 15½" blue scroll pieces to each long side of a tree unit from step 4. Stitch a 12½" x 15½" blue trees piece to the right-hand side to complete the placemat front, noting the orientation of the

pieced tree unit and the printed motifs in the blue trees fabric. Repeat to make a total of (4) placemat fronts.

6. Layer the completed placemat fronts with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2¼" green scroll strips.

⅔ yard	Printed Panel <i>(one full panel)</i>	9683P-09
⅞ yard	Red Snowflakes <i>(includes binding)</i>	9685-88
½ yard	Red Trees	9686-09
1 yard	Red Trees <i>(for backing)</i>	9686-09

Materials for Four Blue Small Placemats

⅔ yard	Printed Panel <i>(one full panel)</i>	9683P-09
½ yard	Blue Trees	9686-01
⅞ yard	Green Scroll <i>(includes binding)</i>	9687-66
1 yard	Blue Trees <i>(for backing)</i>	9686-01

Cutting Instructions for Four Small Placemats

From the printed panel, cut:

- (4) 10½" x 10½" squares, fussy cut, with a printed motif centered in both directions in each square.

From the red OR blue trees, cut:

- (1) 12½" strip. Recut into (8) 3½" x 12½" pieces.

From the red snowflakes OR green scroll, cut:

- (7) 2¼" strips for the binding.
- (5) 1½" strips. Recut into (8) 1½" x 12½" and (8) 1½" x 10½" pieces.

Sewing Instructions for the Small Placemats

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Stitch 1½" x 10½" red snowflakes OR green scroll pieces to the left and right sides of a 10½" trimmed printed panel square. Sew 1½" x 12½" red snowflakes OR green scroll pieces to the top and bottom of the trimmed square.

2. Stitch a 3½" x 12½" red trees OR blue trees piece to the left and right sides of the printed panel square unit from step 1, noting orientation of the printed motifs in all units.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make a total of (4) placemat fronts.

4. Layer the completed placemat fronts with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished placemats using the 2¼" red snowflakes OR green scroll strips.
