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## Materials for the Red Table Runner

3/8 yard	Red Snowflakes	9685-88
1/2 yard	Red Scroll <i>(includes binding)</i>	9687-88
1/4 yard	White Harlequin	9688-09
1/4 yard	Gray Branches	9690-99
5/8 yards	Patchwork Print	9689-09
3/8 yard	Gray Tonal <i>(from Folio Basics Collection)</i>	7755-91
7/8 yard	Red Trees <i>(for backing)</i>	9686-09

## Cutting Instructions for the Red Table Runner

*Please note: all strips, except for the printed stripe, are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.*

### From the red snowflakes, cut:

(5) 1 1/2" strips. Recut into (11) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" pieces.

### From the red scroll, cut:

(1) 3 1/2" strip. Recut into (2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces.

(4) 2 1/4" strips for the binding.

### From EACH of the white harlequin and gray branches, cut:

(1) 3 1/2" strip. Recut into (4) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces.

### From the patchwork print, cut:

(1) 15 1/2" strip. Recut into (2) 13 1/2" x 15 1/2" pieces.

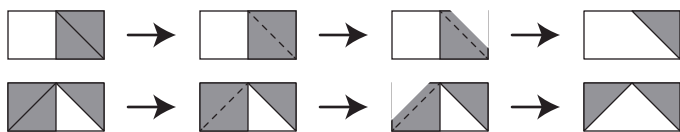
### From the gray tonal, cut:

(2) 3 1/2" strips. Recut into (4) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces and  
(16) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

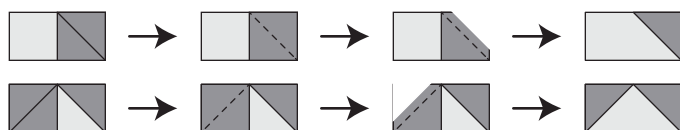
## Sewing Instructions for the Red Table Runner

*All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.*

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3 1/2" gray tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" green branches piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting white triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the green branches piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



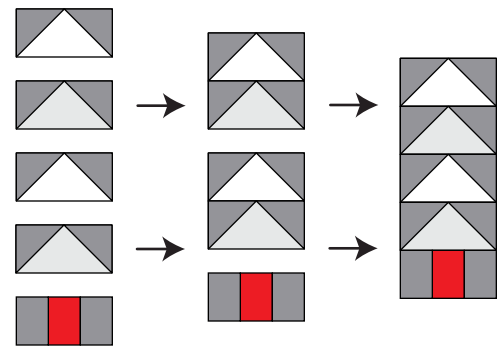
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3 1/2" white tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" green scroll piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting white triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the green scroll piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



3. Stitch 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" white tonal pieces to each long side of a 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" red scroll piece to yield (1) tree trunk unit measuring 3 1/2" x 6 1/2", from raw edge to raw edge, in both directions. Repeat to make a second identical unit.



4. Referring to the diagram below, arrange (2) white harlequin flying geese units, (2) gray branches flying geese units, and (1) tree trunk unit, alternating the two types of flying geese units as shown, and placing the tree trunk unit at the base. Stitch the units together to make (1) tree unit measuring 6 1/2" x 15 1/2", from raw edge to raw edge in both directions. Repeat to make a second identical unit.



5. Using the table runner pictured on the cover as a guide, arrange (3) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" red snowflakes strips and (2) tree units, alternating the strips and the trees, and noting the orientation of each tree. Stitch the units together to complete the center section of the table runner.

6. Stitch a 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" red snowflakes strip to each long side of a 13 1/2" x 15 1/2" patchwork print piece. Repeat to make a second unit.

7. Again using the table runner pictured on the cover as a guide, arrange (4) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" red snowflakes strips, (2) patchwork print units made in step 6, and the center section made in step 5, alternating the strips with the other units, and noting orientation of the printed motifs in the patchwork print units. Stitch the units together to complete the table runner top.

8. Layer the completed table runner top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2 1/4" red scroll strips.



## Materials for the Blue Table Runner

½ yard	Blue Scroll <i>(includes binding)</i>	9687-11
¼ yard	Green Scroll	9687-66
⅜ yard	Blue Harlequin	9688-11
¼ yard	Green Branches	9690-66
⅝ yards	Patchwork Print	9689-09
⅜ yard	White Tonal <i>(from Folio Basics Collection)</i>	7755-01
⅞ yard	Blue Trees <i>(for backing)</i>	9686-01

## Cutting Instructions for the Blue Table Runner

*Please note: all strips, except for the printed stripe, are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.*

### From the blue scroll, cut:

- (1) 3½" strip. Recut into (2) 2½" x 3½" pieces.
- (4) 2¼" strips for the binding.

### From EACH of the green scroll and green branches, cut:

- (1) 3½" strip. Recut into (4) 3½" x 6½" pieces.

### From the blue harlequin, cut:

- (5) 1½" strips. Recut into (11) 1½" x 15½" pieces.

### From the patchwork print, cut:

- (1) 15½" strip. Recut into (2) 13½" x 15½" pieces.

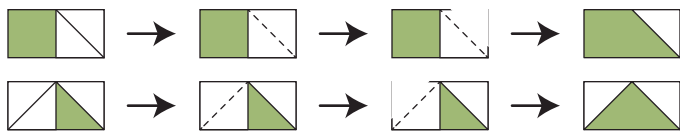
### From the white tonal, cut:

- (2) 3½" strips. Recut into (4) 2½" x 3½" pieces and (16) 3½" x 3½" squares.

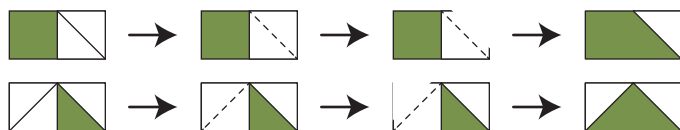
## Sewing Instructions for the Blue Table Runner

*All seams are sewn using ¼" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.*

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3½" white tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3½" x 6½" white harlequin piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim ¼" beyond the seam line and press the resulting gray triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the white harlequin piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



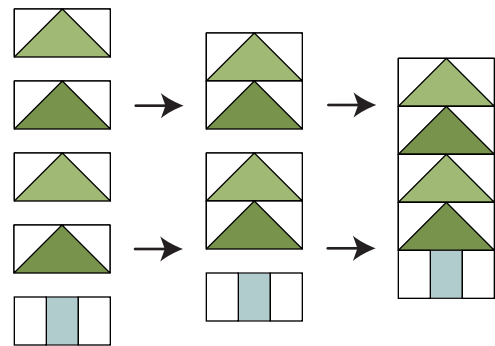
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 3½" gray tonal square. Right sides together, layer the marked square on one end of a 3½" x 6½" gray branches piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Trim ¼" beyond the seam line and press the resulting gray triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the gray branches piece to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical units.



3. Stitch 2½" x 3½" gray tonal pieces to each long side of a 2½" x 3½" blue scroll piece to yield (1) tree trunk unit measuring 3½" x 6½", from raw edge to raw edge, in both directions. Repeat to make a second identical unit.



4. Referring to the diagram below, arrange (2) green branches flying geese units, (2) green scroll flying geese units, and (1) tree trunk unit, alternating the two types of flying geese units as shown, and placing the tree trunk unit at the base. Stitch the units together to make (1) tree unit measuring 6½" x 15½", from raw edge to raw edge in both directions. Repeat to make a second identical unit.



5. Using the table runner pictured on the cover as a guide, arrange (3) 1½" x 15½" blue harlequin strips and (2) tree units, alternating the strips and the trees, and noting the orientation of each tree. Stitch the units together to complete the center section of the table runner.

6. Stitch a 1½" x 15½" blue harlequin strip to each long side of a 13½" x 15½" patchwork print piece. Repeat to make a second unit.

7. Again using the table runner pictured on the cover as a guide, arrange (4) 1½" x 15½" blue harlequin strips, (2) patchwork print units made in step 6, and the center section made in step 5, alternating the strips with the other units, and noting orientation of the printed motifs in the patchwork print units. Stitch the units together to complete the table runner top.

8. Layer the completed table runner top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2¼" blue scroll strips.
